#### Response

1. The Respondent has stated that no part of the claim is contested. Judgment is entered in favour of the Claimant as follows.

#### Redundancy Payment

2. The Claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1,250.25.

#### Holiday Pay

3. The Claimant is entitled to holiday pay of £2,083.75.

#### Total

4. The total of the above awards is **£3,334** and the Respondent is ordered to pay this sum to the Claimant.
