



Geographical spread of COVID-19 in England (aged 60+ years)








DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM North West









DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM



DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM





DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL





Daily deaths within 28 days of positive COVID-19 test in East of England




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM







DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM




