2. COVID-19 Hardship fund (England only)

As part of its response to COVID-19, the government announced in the Budget on 11 March that it would provide local authorities (LAs) in England with £500 million of new grant funding to support economically vulnerable people and households in their local area.

On 24 March 2020, the department published guidance and allocations to billing authorities on delivery of the hardship fund. The guidance and allocation of funding can be found here

Temporary pause of Third Party Deductions in Universal Credit

The Secretary of State confirmed on Thursday 30 April 2020, that there has been an unprecedented 1.5 million Universal Credit (UC) applications made since March 2020. The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) has rightly prioritised the processing of these claims to ensure people get the support they need during the COVID-19 crisis.

Third Party Deductions that have been suspended include: Rent arrears, Service Charge arrears and Council Tax arrears. Direct payments for rent will continue and are not affected by this temporary pause, this also includes Scottish Choices and Managed Payments to Landlords.
