


North East COVID-19 cases: 11 Feb to 17 Feb 2021 Weekly case rates per 100,000 population by local authority


### North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 25 Jan to 17 Feb 2021


### North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 25 Jan to 17 Feb 2021

### North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 25 Jan to 17 Feb 2021





















### Redcar and Cleveland case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Feb 2021








