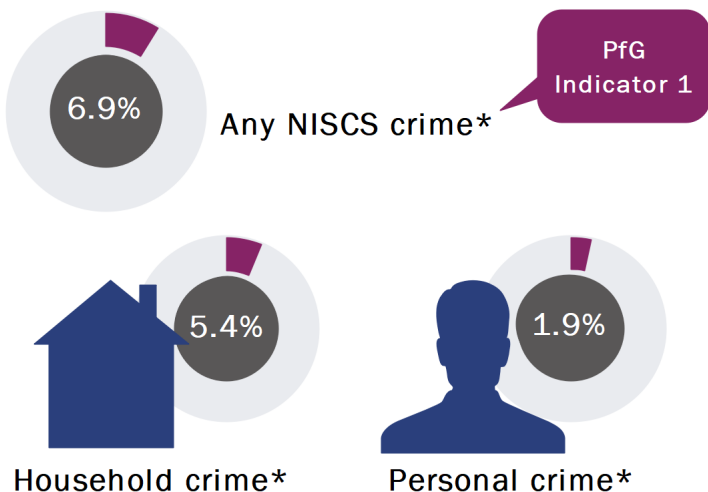
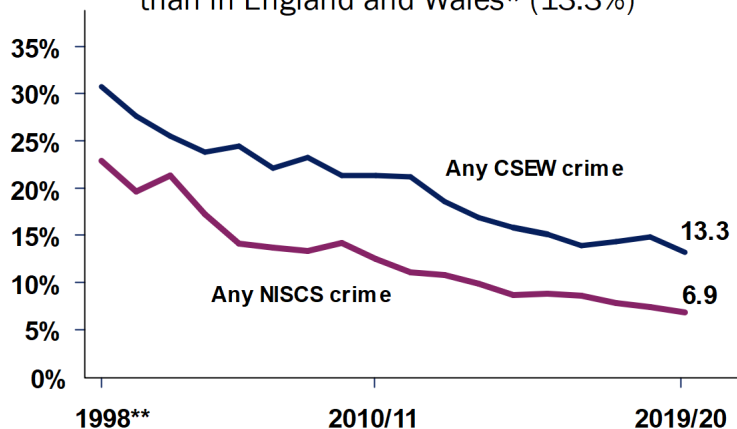


Prevalence Rates



*No significant changes from last year

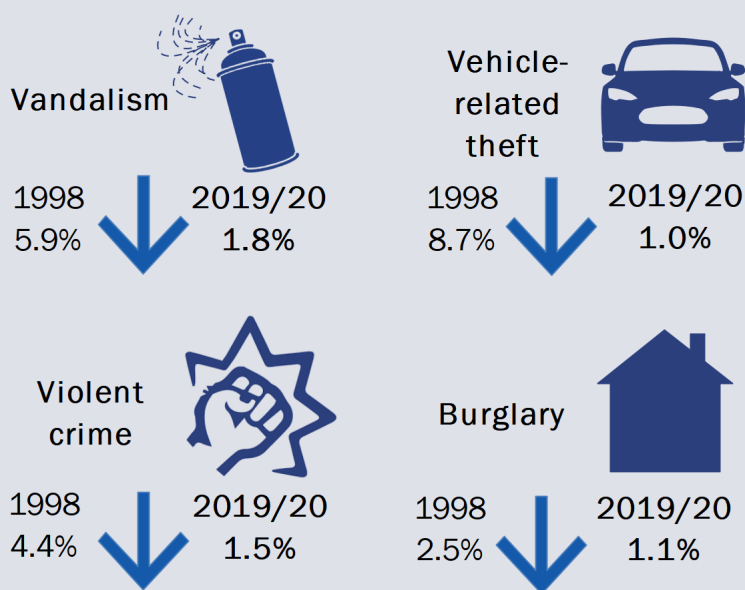
The risk of becoming a victim of crime remains lower in Northern Ireland (6.9%) than in England and Wales* (13.3%)

**First year of data for CSEW refers to 1999

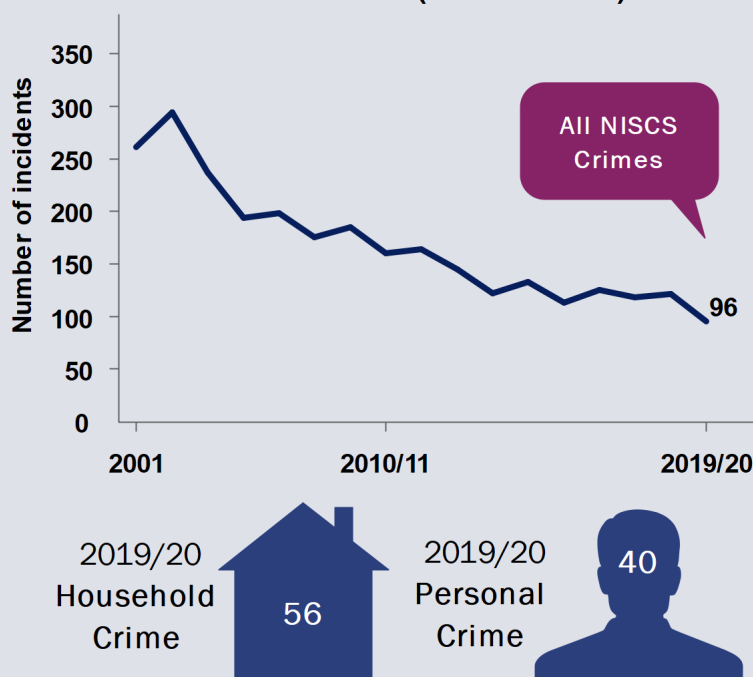
1998 and 2019/20 Prevalence Rates by Crime Type**

In terms of all NISCS 2019/20 crime, results suggest that 45% was reported to the police
