JUDGMENT

The complaint of disability discrimination is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 15 January 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of **disability discrimination** should not be struck out because

- it has no reasonable prospect of success.

2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of disability discrimination is therefore struck out.

3. The claimant's remaining claim of unlawful deduction from wages will now be listed for a hearing and separate case management orders made.
