## CASSOP NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE NO.02 DECLARATION 2021

In accordance with section 19(3) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 (as amended), and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare that:

The land having a total area of 17.86 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parish of Cassop-cum-Quarrington in the Unitary Authority of County Durham and shown cross hatched and un-shaded on the attached maps (which land was included in the Cassop Vale National Nature Reserve No.01 Declaration made by the Nature Conservancy Council for England on the 11th day of July 1996) is no longer the subject of a nature reserve agreement and has ceased to be managed as a nature reserve.

The land shown shaded yellow and unhatched on the attached maps having a total area of 6.84 hectares or thereabouts remains declared and is to be known henceforth as Cassop National Nature Reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Cassop National Nature Reserve No.02 Declaration 2021.
