Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). You requested the following information:

RE: Betteshanger site in the Dover District Council (DDC) area – planning reference 20/00419

"It is now clear that this project will make best use of a site which has seen a significant level of publicly funded investment in the form of infrastructure brought forward by SEEDA and subsequent Agencies to pump-prime the land for development. This investment included the delivery of roads and utilities to serve the platforms created across the former colliery site."

I would like to ask for the sources of information on the Betteshanger development used by Homes England on which this judgement is based.

Response

We are able to inform you that we do hold the information that you have requested. However, we rely on section 21, exemption where information is available to the applicant elsewhere.

21 - Information accessible to applicant by other means.

(1)Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under section 1 is exempt information.

(2)For the purposes of subsection (1)-

(a)information may be reasonably accessible to the applicant even though it is accessible only on payment, and

(b)information is to be taken to be reasonably accessible to the applicant if it is information which the public authority or any other person is obliged by or under any enactment to communicate (otherwise than by making the information available for inspection) to members of the public on request, whether free of charge or on payment.

(3)For the purposes of subsection (1), information which is held by a public authority and does not fall within subsection (2)(b) is not to be regarded as reasonably accessible to the applicant merely because the information is available from the public authority itself on request, unless the information is made available in accordance with the authority's publication scheme and any payment required is specified in, or determined in accordance with, the scheme.
