RE: Request for Information - RFI3300

Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). You requested the following information:

Residents living on what is termed 'phase 1' of the Tall Trees development at Yarm, have been advised by the Minister of State for Housing that the bid for funding to be provided to Broadacres Housing Association for the development of phase 2 of the Tall Trees site, was supported as it took into consideration "...situated on a main bus route, with the train station linking to Darlington and Stockton.....".

I believe such a statement is open to question.

Could I therefore request under the Freedom of Information Act that you:

- 1. Provide the relevant part of the bid documentation which states the above, including name, job title, company and date of the submission.
- 2. If the above submission was by Broadacres Housing Association, who from Stockton Borough Council supported the bid, (name, job title and date).

Response

We can confirm that we do hold some information that falls within the scope of your request. We will address each of your points in turn.

1. Provide the relevant part of the bid documentation which states the above, including name, job title, company and date of the submission.

We are able to confirm that Homes England does not hold the information detailed in your request. This is because there is no legal or business reason for Homes England to do so.

In order to conclude that the information is not held, we have searched with our Affordable Housing team who would have the requested information if held.

The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty under section 1(1) is only to provide the recorded information held.

Advice and Assistance

We have a duty to provide advice and assistance in accordance with Section 16 of the FOIA. To comply with this duty we are able to confirm that although our Affordable Housing team moderated and approved the bid for funding for Tall Trees, the bid does not contain the information requested. The bid does not contain any reference to bus routes or train stations.

It may be that this information formed part of the Planning Application between Broadacres and the Local Authority. The planning application is not a required document for Homes England to assess and we do not have sight of the planning application as part of our bid approval process. The planning application is dealt with directly between the provider (Broadacres) and the Local Authority. We can advise that you may be able to request the planning application from the Local Authority, though cannot confirm it contains the information you are seeking.

2. If the above submission was by Broadacres Housing Association, who from Stockton Borough Council supported the bid, (name, job title and date).

We can confirm that Broadacres submitted a bid for funding for the Tall Trees development under the Affordable Housing Programme and this was supported by Stockton Borough Council.

The support of the Council is provided in the attached Annex A.

We have redacted information in Annex A and are withholding from disclosure the personal information requested, as this is exempt from disclosure under Section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Section 40 – Personal information

We have redacted information on the grounds that in constitutes third party personal data and therefore engages section 40(2) of the FOIA.

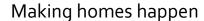
To disclose personal data, such as names, contact details, addresses, email addresses and personal opinions could lead to the identification of third parties and would breach one or more of the data protection principles.

Section 40 is an absolute exemption which means that we do not need to consider the public interest in disclosure. Once it is established that the information is personal data of a third party and release would breach one or more of the data protection principles, then the exemption is engaged.

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Broadacres submit bids for funding under the Affordable Housing Programme via Homes England's Investment Management System (IMS). The Tall Trees scheme was submitted via IMS to Homes England in January 2020 for inclusion in the Broadacres programme of funding.

Right to Appeal

Your request for review must be made in writing, explain why you wish to appeal, and be received within 40 working days of the date of this response. Failure to meet this criteria may lead to your request being refused.

Upon receipt, your request for review will be passed to an independent party not involved in your original request. We aim to issue a response within 20 working days.

You may also complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) however, the Information Commissioner does usually expect the internal review procedure to be exhausted in the first instance.
