In order to conclude that the information is not held, we have searched with our Human Resources team who would have the requested information if held.

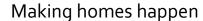
The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty under section 1(1) is only to provide the recorded information held.
