

North East COVID-19 cases: 18 Feb to 24 Feb 2021 Weekly case rates per 100,000 population by local authority






North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 1 Feb to 24 Feb 2021


North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 1 Feb to 24 Feb 2021

North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 1 Feb to 24 Feb 2021





County Durham case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 28 Feb 2021



















Redcar and Cleveland case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 28 Feb 2021







Stockton-on-Tees case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 28 Feb 2021




