#### **JUDGMENT**

## The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed by the respondent.
- 2. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant compensation in the following sum:
  - a. a basic award in the sum of £3127.30.
  - b. a compensatory award in the sum of £2525.30

The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant a total compensation award in the sum of £5652.60.

- 3. The claimant at termination of his employment had an accrued entitlement to 142.3 hours and had an entitlement to payment in lieu of untaken holiday in the sum of £1168. The respondent paid to the claimant the sum of £500.00 on account of his holiday entitlement and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of the balance due £668.00 accrued and untaken holiday.
- 4. The respondent failed to give the claimant ten weeks statutory notice of

- termination of his employment. The damage suffered by the claimant is extinguished by the compensatory award made for the relevant period.
- 5. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £6320.60 being the grand total of the monies outstanding and due of the awards made.
