JUDGMENT

- 1. The following claims have been upheld against Boxed Freeze Ltd:
 - (i) Statutory redundancy payment
 - (ii) Notice pay
 - (iii) Unauthorised deduction from wages in respect of unpaid wages
 - (iv) Failure to provide a written statement of terms contrary to s1 Employment Rights Act 1996 (s38 ERA 1996)
- 2. The Claimant's claims against Coolertech Ltd are not upheld as they were not the claimant's employer.
- 3. All figures below are expressed in gross terms.

Boxed Freeze Limited is ordered to pay:

(i)	Statutory redundancy payment	<u>£1,080</u>
(ii)	Notice pay	£720
(iii)	Unpaid wages	<u>£1440</u>

(iv)	Holiday pay	<u>£360</u>
(v)	Failure to provide written statement of terms contrary to S 1 ERA 1996	£1,440
