


North East COVID-19 cases: 25 Feb to 03 Mar 2021 Weekly case rates per 100,000 population by local authority


North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 8 Feb to 3 Mar 2021


North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 8 Feb to 3 Mar 2021

North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 8 Feb to 3 Mar 2021




North East regional case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


County Durham case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Darlington case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Gateshead case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Hartlepool case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Middlesbrough case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021




North Tyneside case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Northumberland case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


Redcar and Cleveland case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


South Tyneside case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 7 Mar 2021


