I write in response to an email you sent to me on 18 November 2019. You requested all documentation and/or information held by the Commissioner relating to HikVision and its involvement (or possible involvement) in any activities which could be construed as being a violation of established human rights in any territory. Your request has been handled as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Q1. A request of all documentation and/or information held by the Commission related to HikVision and its involvement (or possible involvement) in any activities which could be construed as being a violation of established human rights in any territory.

I am an independent regulator supported by Home Office staff who make use of Home Office systems and resources. I do not hold the information which you have requested.

If you are dissatisfied with this response you may request an independent internal review of our handling of your request by submitting a complaint within two months to the address below, quoting reference SCC/FOI/18/19/OA. If you ask for an internal review, it would be helpful if you could say why you are dissatisfied with the response.
