


Geographical Spread of COVID-19 in England



- The vertical axis plots the most recent weekly case rate per 100k people (up to the 10 March), and the horizontal axis plots the equivalent case rate from the week before. Bubbles above the black dashed line represent areas where weekly case rates increased from one week to another.
- •The size of each bubble is proportional to the most recent case rate per 100k people in those aged over 60 years.
- •The colour of each bubble indicates which region the area is in.




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM







DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM














DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM





Daily deaths within 28 days of positive COVID-19 test in East of England




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM







DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM






Regional age-stratified case rate heatmap for South West: 15 Feb


