HUMBERHEAD PEATLANDS NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE NO.04 DECLARATION 2021

The land shown un-hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map has already been declared a National Nature Reserve in the Humberhead Peatlands National Nature Reserve No.01 Declaration 1995, No.02 Declaration 1996 and No.03 Declaration 2005. Natural England now wishes to extend this National Nature Reserve.

The land having a total area of 14.19 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parish of Crowle and Ealand in the Unitary Authority of North Lincolnshire and shown diagonal hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map is held by Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust, a body approved by Natural England, and is being managed as a nature reserve.

The land having a total area of 83.10 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parish of Goole Fields in the Unitary Authority of East Riding of Yorkshire, the Parish of Crowle and Ealand in the Unitary Authority of North Lincolnshire and the Parishes of Hatfield and Thorne in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster and shown vertical hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map has been acquired and is held by Natural England and is being managed as a nature reserve.

Natural England is satisfied that the said land is of national importance.

And in pursuance of section 19(1) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare the land referred to herein and more particularly shown on the map attached hereto a National Nature Reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Humberhead Peatlands National Nature Reserve No.04 Declaration 2021.
