APPLICATION FOR WARRANT OF ARREST

Sections 313 and 317 of the Armed Forces Act 2006 and The Armed Forces (Warrants of Arrest for Service Offences) Rules 2009

This application form is to be used to apply to a Judge Advocate for a warrant to arrest a person under one of the situations below. In all cases, the warrant (if issued) will be addressed to an officer or officers of a UK police force or British overseas territory police force. The applicant should tick which box applies:

Under section 313(1) of the Act, where the person is reasonably suspected of having committed a service offence (complete Parts A, B, C and D);

Under section 317(1)(a) of the Act, where the person (having surrendered to the civil police) has been released but subject to a condition that he reports at or by such time to such place or person as may be specified, and the person has failed to comply with that condition (complete Parts A, B, C and E); or

Under section 317(1)(b) of the Act, where the person (having been arrested by the civil police for absence or desertion) has been released by a court of summary jurisdiction, but subject to a condition that he reports at or by such time to such place or person as may be specified, and the person has failed to comply with that condition (complete Parts A, B, C and E)
