





Weekly case rate and rate of change per 100,000 population by Local Authority










- The vertical axis plots the most recent weekly case rate per 100k people (up to the 14 March), and the horizontal axis plots the equivalent case rate from the week before. The higher the bubble, the worse the current case rate picture.
- •The size of each bubble is proportional to the most recent case rate per 100k people in those aged over 60 years.
- •The colour of each bubble indicates which region the area is in.




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM









DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM





Deaths within 28 days of positive COVID-19 test




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM


