





Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 22 Feb to 17 Mar 2021



Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 22 Feb to 17 Mar 2021














Calderdale case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021


Craven case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021

























Age-stratified case rate heatmap for North Lincolnshire: 22 Feb


Rotherham case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021




Scarborough case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021


Selby case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021


Sheffield case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 21 Mar 2021


