## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

## REASONS

This claim was presented in 2018 and a final hearing was delayed because of Covid. The Tribunal has been told that the reason for the claimant's non-attendance at a hearing before me on 27 April 2020 was that he had sadly passed away. Various attempts have been made in correspondence since then to understand whether the claim is pursued by his representatives with no response. The last attempt warning of the possibility of strike out of the claim for it not being pursued by those representatives was sent on 26 February 2021. There has been no response. I have concluded that as it is a year or more since the claimant passed away and there has been no contact from those representatives (and with my condolences to his family) the claim must be struck out.
