JUDGMENT

- 1) The claimant's complaint of breach of contact (notice pay) is well founded. The claimant is awarded the sum of £461.54 (gross).
- 2) The claimant's complaint of unlawful deductions from wages is well founded. The claimant is awarded unpaid wages for the period 10 August 2020 10 September 2020 in the sum of 2215.39 (gross).
- 3) The claimant's complaint of breach of the working time regulations (holiday pay) is also well founded. The claimant is awarded the sum of £263.73.
- 4) The Tribunal has uplifted the awards for breach of contract and unlawful deduction from wages by 10% for failure to follow the ACAS Code of practice. The respondent is therefore ordered to pay the additional sum of £267.69
