The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, no objection having been received to a draft order submitted to him by the Penwith District Council and published in accordance with Schedule 3 to the Harbours Act 1964 and being satisfied that the making of the order is desirable in the interests of securing the improvement, maintenance and management of St. Ives Harbour in an efficient and economical manner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 14 of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

 As originally enacted

1.— Citation and commencement

(1) This Order may be cited as the St. Ives Harbour Revision Order 1980 and shall come into operation on the date fixed in accordance with the provisions of the Statutory Orders (Special Procedure) Acts 1945 and 1965¹.

(2) The St. Ives Harbour Act 1853, the St. Ives Harbour Order 1862², the St. Ives Harbour Orders 1886 and 1888³ and this Order may be cited together as the St. Ives Harbour Act and Orders 1853 to 1980.

2. Amendment of Order of 1886

Article 37 (Rights of mortgagees and creditors) of the St. Ives Harbour Order 1886 is hereby amended by the revocation of the words “nor shall any debts transferred to or incurred by or engagements entered into by the Corporation for or in respect of the harbour”.

3. Costs of Order

The costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing, applying for and obtaining of this Order and otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Penwith District Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

As originally enacted

This Order extends the powers of the Penwith District Council in connection with the harbour of St. Ives to meet deficiencies in their income from that harbour out of their general rate fund.

The Order being subject to special parliamentary procedure, the provisions of the Statutory Orders (special Procedure) Acts 1945 and 1965 determine the date upon which it comes into operation.

The applicants for this Order are the Penwith District Council whose offices are situate at St. Clare, Penzance, Cornwall.
