1 Background

Data Quality

Fire stations information is supplied to the Home Office by Fire and rescue services (FRSs).

Dataset rationale

The Home Office answered a collection of FOIs regarding the names and addresses of fire stations in England. This dataset answers these questions in a consistent way that is available to all. Fire stations and their locations will be useful for geographical analyses.

Dataset definition

This dataset covers England only. Fire stations do not include non-operational headquarter buildings, fire control buildings and other non-operational buildings. The information was supplied to the Home Office in December 2017 and January 2018 by FRSs and updated in July 2020.

The figures in this dataset are slightly different to the figures published in table FIRE1403 because they were collected during a different time period.
