CONSENT JUDGMENT

Paragraph 27 of the Reasons of Employment Judge JM Wade of 15 February 2021 and sent to the parties on 17 February 2021 be varied to remove the words in parenthesis within paragraph 27, "and Mr Hastie acquitted" such that the paragraph be varied to:

"27 There was also the issue of postponement because of related criminal proceedings, the claimant reasserting that there was a second criminal investigation involving allegations against Mr Hastie in connection with their former relationship (a first prosecution for assault had been discontinued). I directed that I would consider that matter, and whether it was just for this hearing to continue, after I had done some preliminary reading."

JUDGMENT

- 1 In all other respects the application dated 28 February 2021 sent at 20.48 for reconsideration of the reasons is rejected.
- 2 To the extent that the claimant's email of 11 March 2021 at 8.43 contains a further application to reconsider the above paragraph, it is refused because there is no prospect of the reasons being further varied or revoked.

REASONS

- 1 There are no prospects of the reasons being varied as sought in points 2 to 11 of the 28 February application. A substantially similar application has already been made and refused. It is in the interests of justice for the parties to have finality.
- 2 The matter raised in the 11 March application relates to a finding in paragraph 27 based on the material at the hearing. It cannot be said to be wrong, let alone perverse, on a interpretation of what was said by the claimant at the hearing and the documents before the Tribunal.
