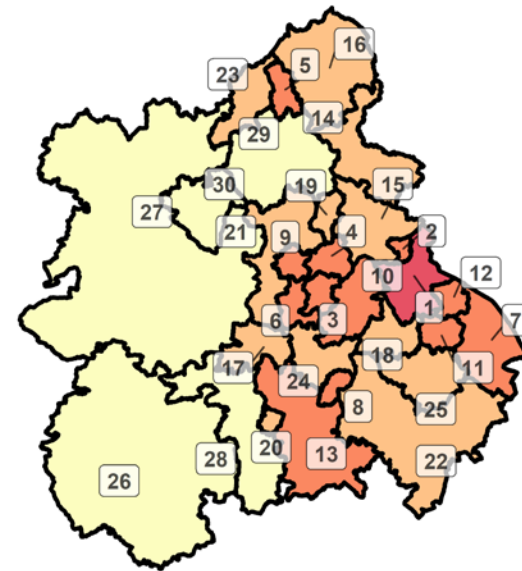

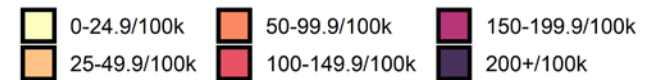

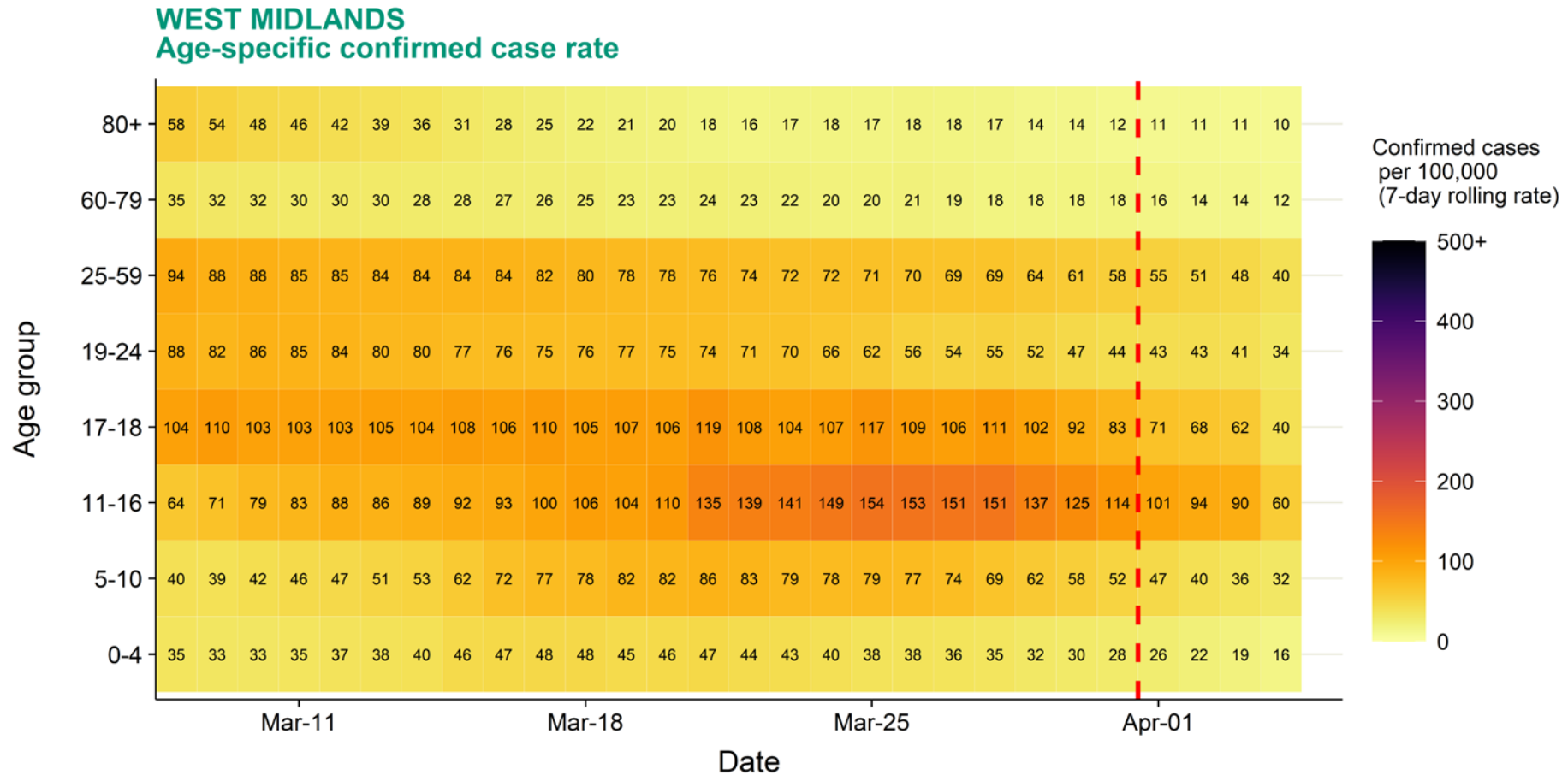
Covid-19 rate by local authority

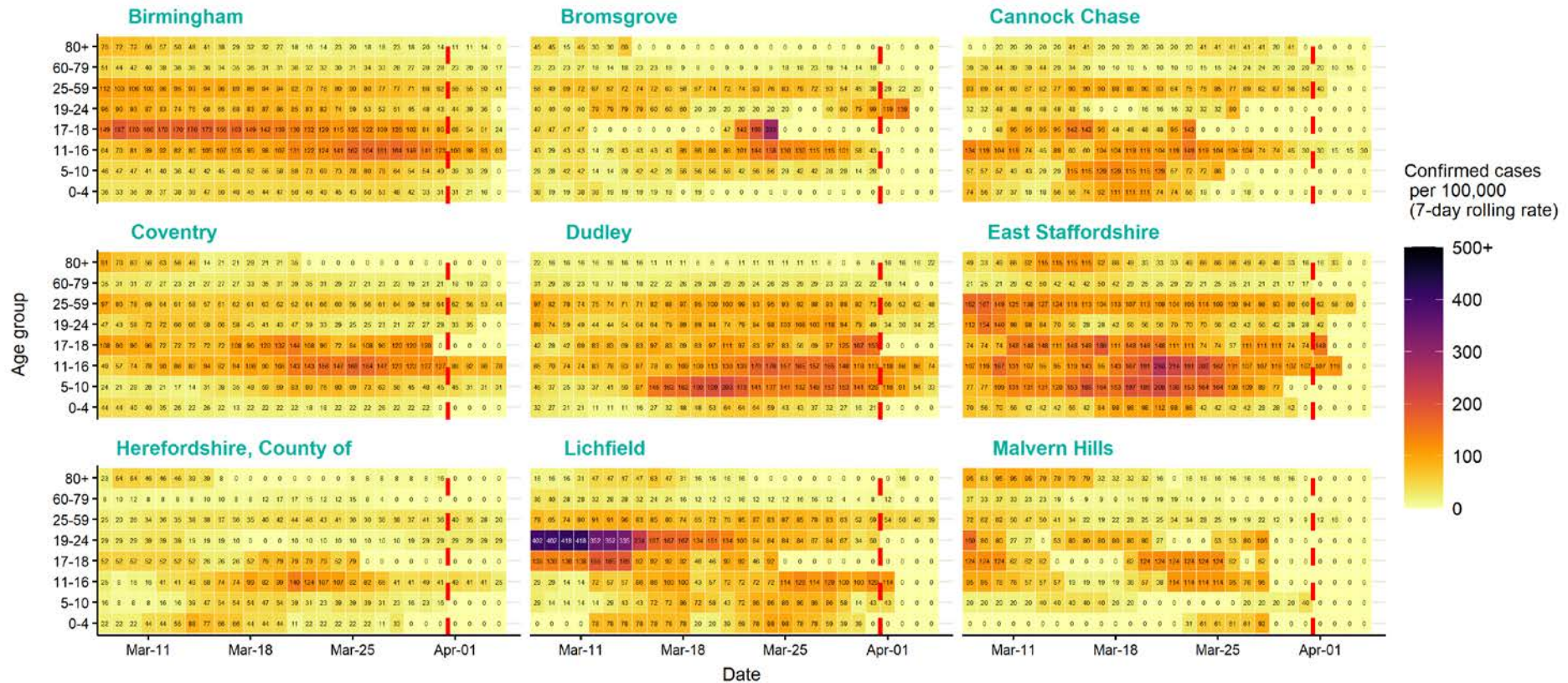

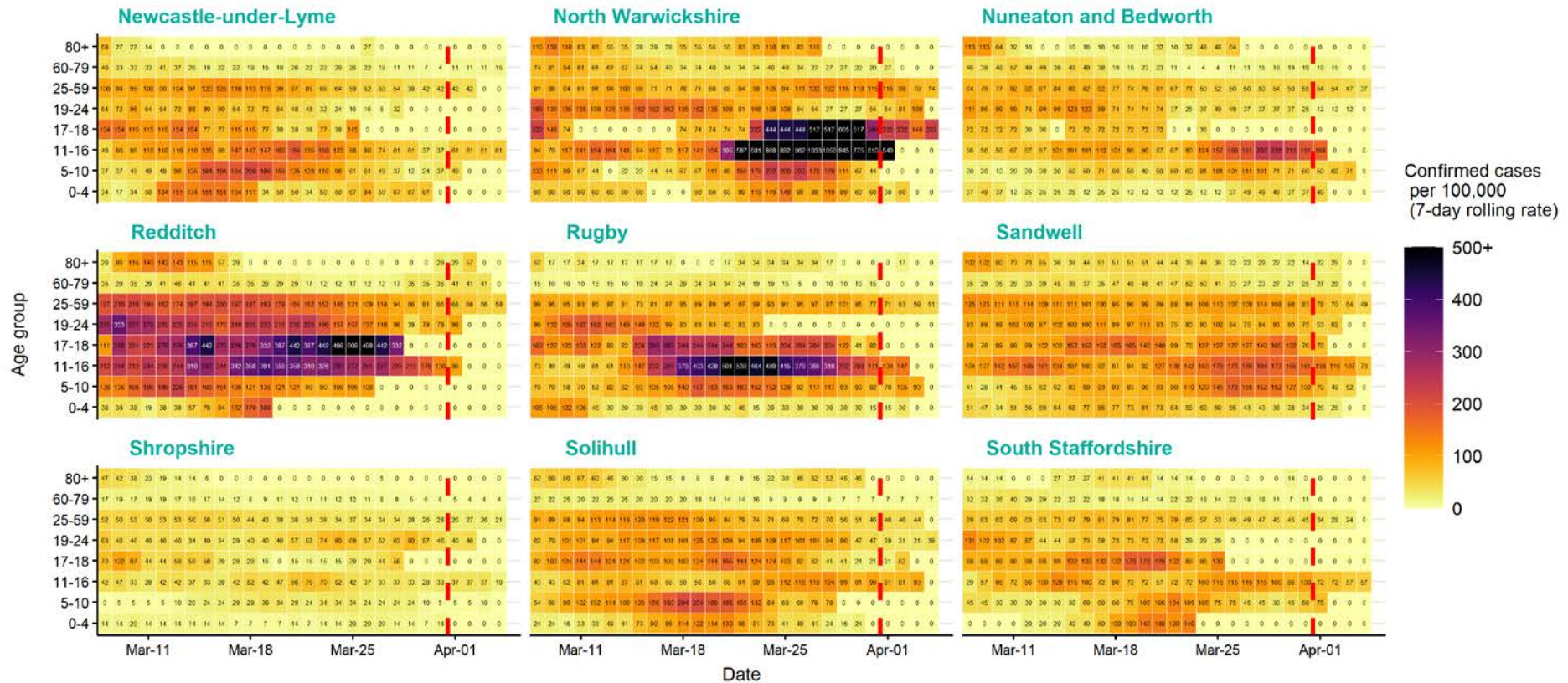

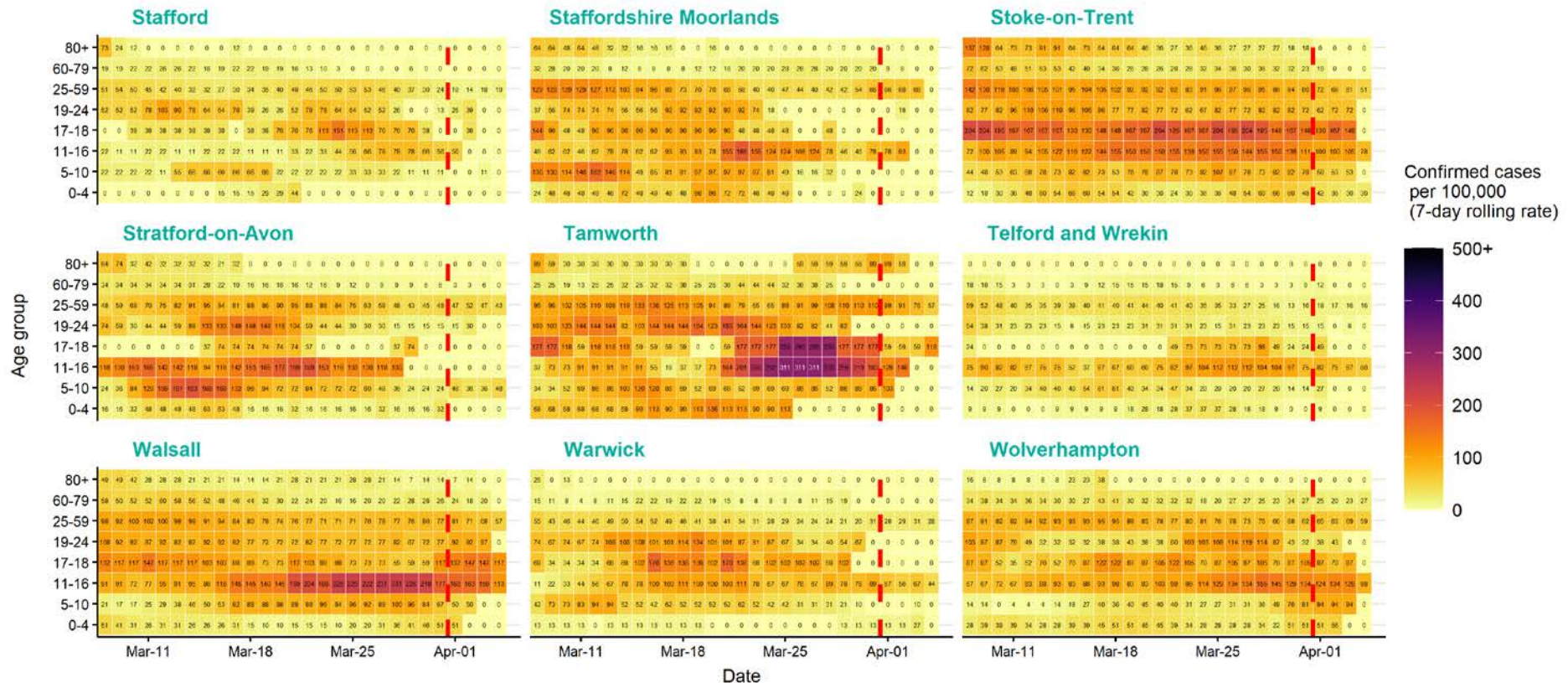

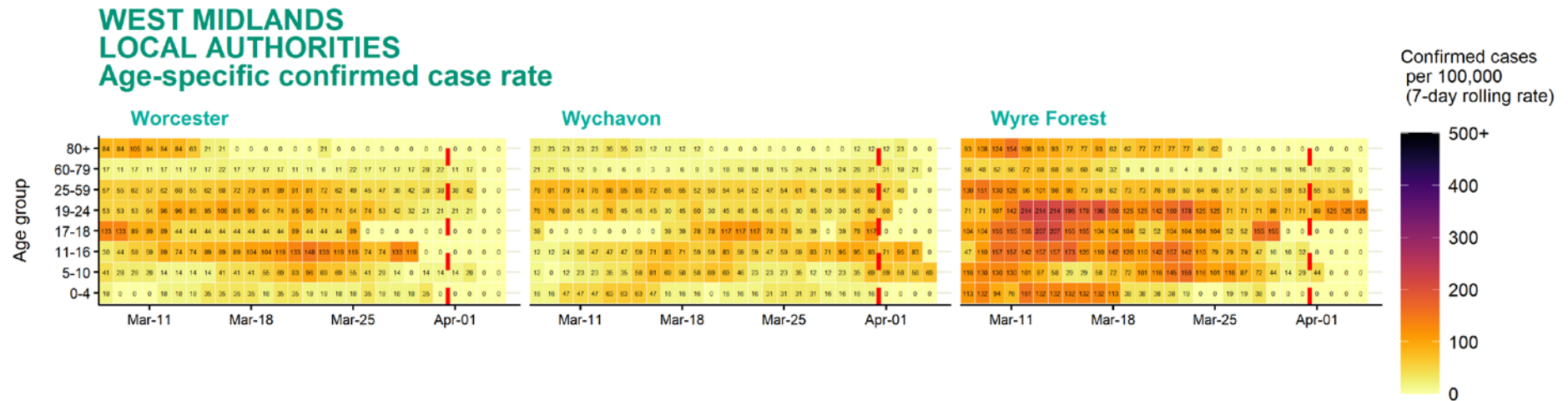

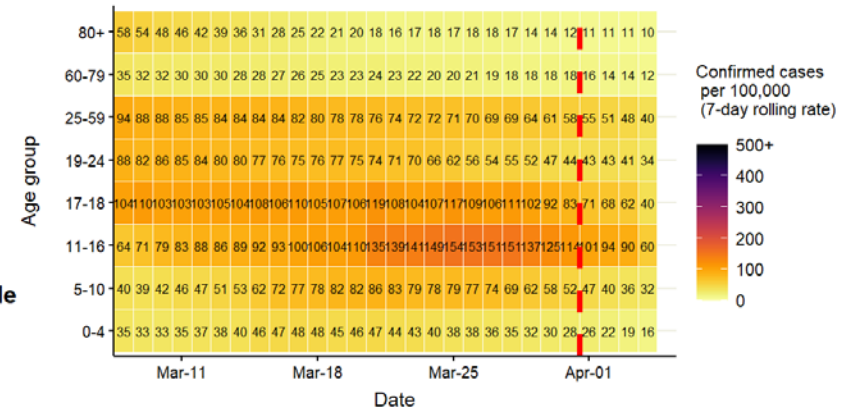

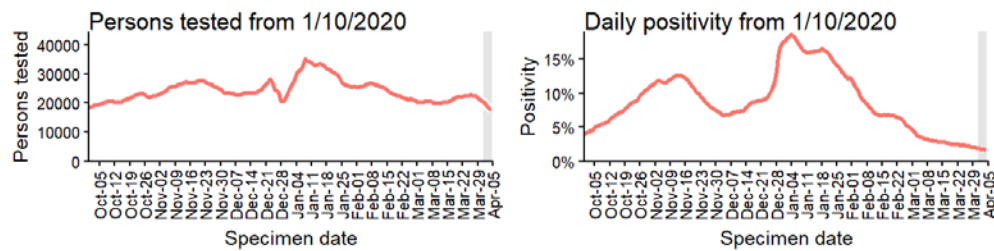

Regional age-stratified case rate heatmap for West Midlands: 8 Mar to 4 Apr 2021,



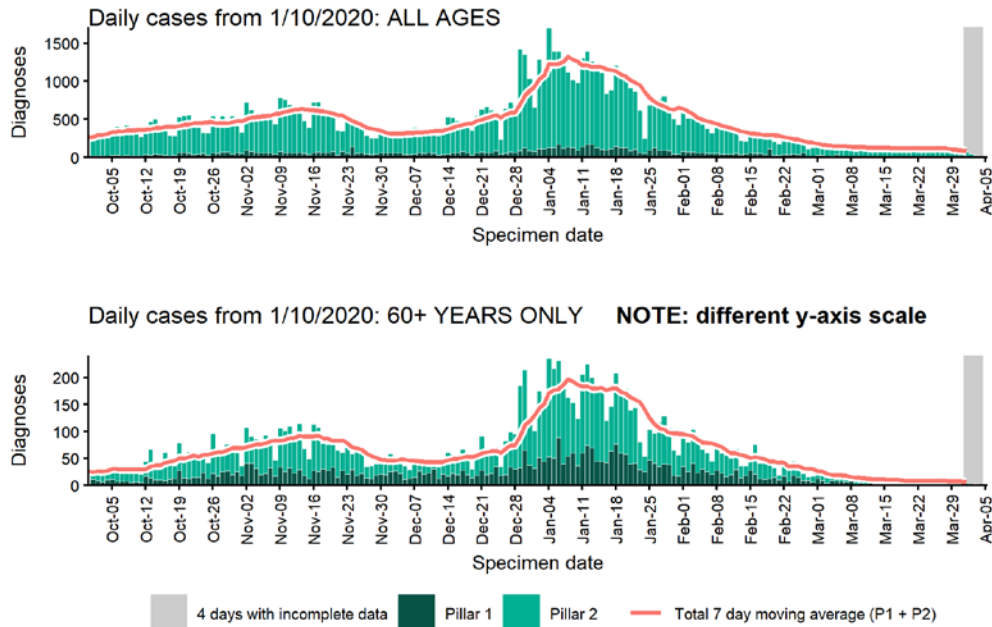

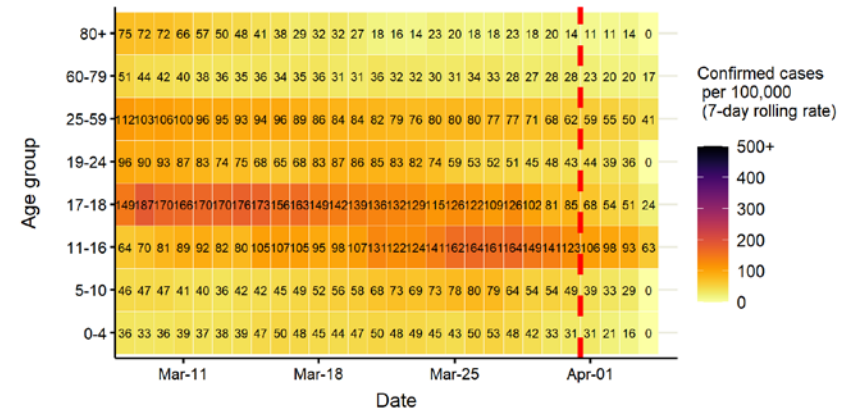

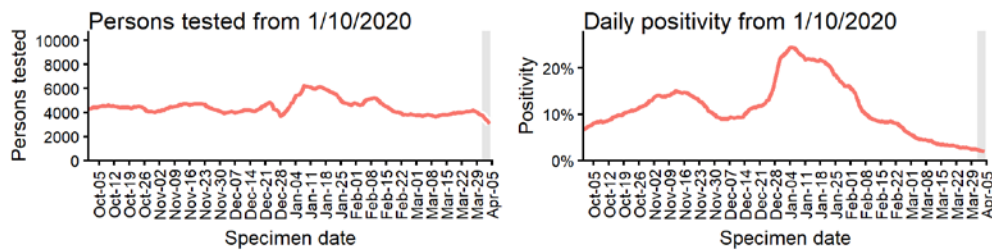

Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Birmingham: 8 Mar to 4 Apr 2021



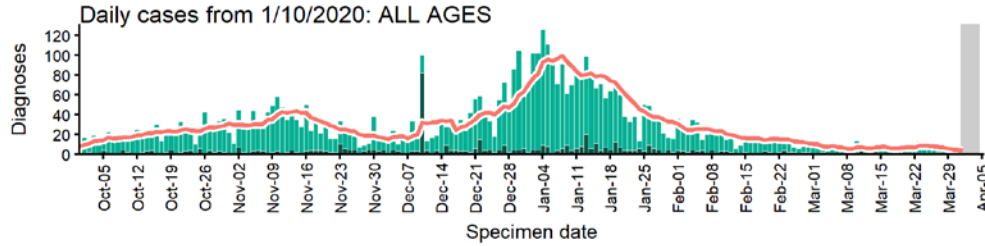

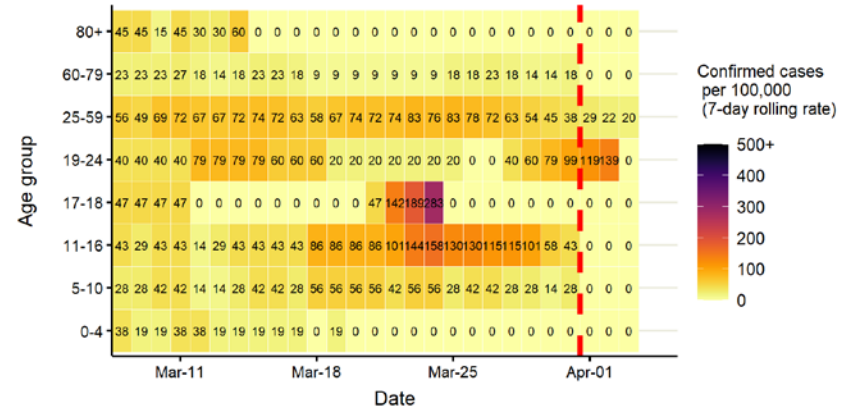

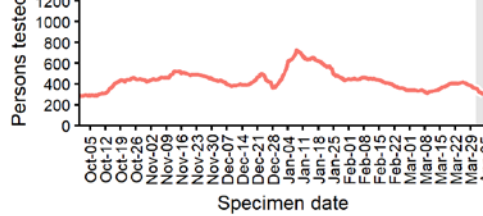

Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Stratford-on-Avon: 8 Mar to 4 Apr 2021



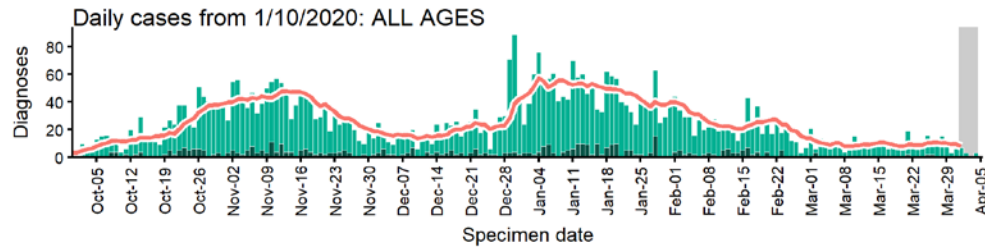
