JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

- 1. The respondent company is in administration. Neither the consent of the Administrator nor the permission of the court has been obtained for these proceedings to be continued as required by the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 2. On 7 December 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons why the claim should not be struck out as it had not been actively pursued. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason. The administrators have confirmed that consent to proceed has not been given, yet the claimant has given no indication that he intends to pursue an application to the court.
- 3. The claim is therefore struck out because it has not been actively pursued.
