## JUDGMENT

- 1. The tribunal has no power to hear the claimant's claims for unfair dismissal and notice pay. They were presented out of time in circumstances when it was reasonably practicable for them to have been presented within time, and they are struck out.
- 2. The tribunal has no power to hear the claimant's claims for any form of discrimination. They were presented out of time and it is not just and equitable to extend time. They are struck out.
- 3. The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment has no reasonable prospect of success and is struck out.
