

The member may raise any such concern with one or more of the following as deemed appropriate to raise it with : the officials of WISA, the trustees of the property of WISA, the Auditors of WISA, the Certification officer (who is an independent officer appointed by the Secretary of State) or the police.

Where a member believes that the financial affairs of WISA have been or are being conducted in breach of the law or in breach of WISA rules and contemplates bringing civil proceedings against WISA, its Officers or Trustees the member should consider obtaining independent legal advice.
