Construction noise and vibration Monthly Report – February 2021

London Borough of Camden

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Non-Technical Summary

This Noise and Vibration Monitoring Report fulfils HS2 Limited's commitment detailed in the Environmental Minimum Requirements (EMRs), Annex 1, Code of Construction Practice, to present the results of noise and vibration monitoring carried out within the London Borough of Camden during the month of February 2021.

Within this period monitoring was undertaken at the following worksites:

- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of The Adelaide Road Ventilation Shaft (ref.: ARVS), where vegetation clearance, trench excavations, installation of hardstanding for laydown areas and temporary haul road, utility diversion works, relocation of dry room, central gate ramp construction, working platform construction and lighting works were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of Euston Throat Retained Cut worksite (ref.: ETRC) where guide wall construction, silo installation and grouting, excavations, ground compaction and piling were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of Euston Scissor Cut worksite (ref.: ESC)
 where pile installation, groundworks, installation of pile mat and guide walls, access
 ramp installation, surveys and haul road maintenance were underway.
- Noise and vibration monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Hampstead Road Bridge worksite (ref.: HRB), where hoarding and haul road access works and installation of traffic management systems were underway.
- Noise and vibration monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Euston Cavern worksite (ref.: ECAV), where testing of ground anchors, bridge investigations, hoarding works and trial of sheet piling were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of On-Network worksites (ref.: B, C, D, E, F, G and H), where
 - o fencing installation (worksite B);
 - o overhead line equipment inspections and adjustments, signalling and cabling works (worksites C, D, E, F and G);
 - o cable and signal recoveries and drainage works (worksites C, D and E);
 - o resurfacing, cutline installation and demolition works (worksites G and H); and
 - o erection of an access scaffold (worksite F) were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the 140 Hampstead Road and Power Signal Box worksite (ref.: S001-WS02), where groundworks, pile cap removal and minor demolitions were underway.

- Noise and vibration monitoring were undertaken in the vicinity of the Wolfson House, Walkden House, 67-75 & 77-79 Euston Road worksite (ref.: S003-WS03) where excavation of utility trenches and groundworks were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Former National Temperance Hospital, 110 Hampstead Road worksite (ref.: S003-WS06), where deliveries were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Former National Temperance Hospital Euston North worksite (ref.: NTH-EN), where clearance of plant and materials, working platform installation and completion of footpaths and walkways were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Euston Towers Demolition worksite (ref.: EDT), where site setup and core drilling were underway.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of the Vehicle Holding Area worksite (ref.: VHA), where concrete slab construction and site setup were underway.

Further works were also undertaken at:

- Hampstead Road, Stephenson Way, Melton Street, North Gower Street, Regnart Buildings and Harrington Street, where utilities works were underway.
- The Interim Taxi Rank worksite where ground load bearing testing, construction of concrete crossovers, tree removal and waste clearance, establishment of welfare compound and site setup were underway.

There was one exceedance of the HS2 threshold levels for significant noise effects during the reporting period.

There were no exceedances of trigger levels as defined in section 61 consents during the reporting period at one monitoring position.

Twelve (12) complaints were received during the monitoring period. A description of complaints, the results of investigations and any actions taken are detailed in Table 8 of this report.

Ambient sound	A description of the all-encompassing sound at a given location and time which will include sound from many sources near and far. Ambient sound can be quantified in terms of the equivalent continuous sound pressure level, L _{pAeq,T}
Decibel(s), or dB	Between the quietest audible sound and the loudest tolerable sound there is a million to one ratio in sound pressure (measured in Pascal (Pa)). Because of this wide range, a level scale called the decibel (dB) scale, based on a logarithmic ratio, is used in sound measurement. Audibility of sound covers a range of approximately 0-140dB.
Decibel(s) A- weighted, or dB(A)	The human ear system does not respond uniformly to sound across the detectable frequency range and consequently instrumentation used to measure sound is weighted to represent the performance of the ear. This is known as the 'A weighting' and is written as 'dB(A)'.
Equivalent continuous sound pressure level, or L _{Aeq,T}	An index used internationally for the assessment of environmental sound impacts. It is defined as the notional unchanging level that would, over a given period of time (T), deliver the same sound energy as the actual time-varying sound over the same period. Hence fluctuating sound levels can be described in terms of an equivalent single figure value, typically expressed as a decibel level.
Exclusion of data	Measurement of noise levels can be affected by weather conditions such as prolonged periods of rain, winds speeds higher than 5m/s and snow/ice ground cover. Noise levels measured during these periods are considered not representative of normal noise conditions at the site and, for the purposes of this report, are excluded from the assessment of exceedances and calculation of typical noise levels and are also greyed out in charts. Identifiable incongruous noise and vibration events not attributable to HS2 construction noise are also excluded.
Façade	A facade noise level is the noise level 1m in front of a large reflecting surface. The effect of reflection, is to produce a slightly higher (typically +2.5 to +3 dB) sound level than it would be if the reflecting surface was not there.
Free-field	A free-field noise level is the noise level measured at a location where no reflective surfaces, other than the ground, lies within 3.5 metres of the microphone position.
LOAEL	Lowest Observed Adverse Effect Level - the level above which adverse effects on health and quality of life can be detected.
Peak particle velocity, or PPV	Instantaneous maximum velocity reached by a vibrating element as it oscillates about its rest position. The PPV is a simple indicator of perceptibility and risk of damage to structures due to vibration. It is usually measured in mm/s.
SOAEL	Significant Observed Adverse Effect Level - the level above which significant adverse effects on health and quality of life occur.
Sound pressure level	The parameter by which sound levels are measured in air. It is measured in decibels. The threshold of hearing has been set at 0dB, while the threshold of pain is approximately 120dB. Normal speech is approximately 60dB at a distance of 1 metre and a change of 3dB in a time varying sound signal is commonly regarded as being just detectable. A change of 10dB is subjectively twice, or half, as loud.
Vibration dose value, or VDV	An index used to evaluate human exposure to vibration in buildings. While the PPV provides information regarding the magnitude of single vibration events, the VDV provides a measure of the total vibration experienced over a specified period of time (typically 16h daytime and 8h night-time). It takes into account the magnitude, the number and the duration of vibration events and can be used to quantify exposure to continuous, impulsive, occasional and intermittent vibration. The vibration dose value is measured in m/s ^{1,75} .

1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 HS2 is required to undertake noise (and vibration) monitoring as necessary to comply with the requirements of the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Environmental Minimum Requirements, including specifically Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice, in addition to any monitoring requirements arising from conditions imposed through consents under Section 61 of the Control of Pollution Act, 1974 or through Undertakings & Assurances given to third parties. Such monitoring may be undertaken for the following purposes:
 - monitoring the impact of construction works;
 - to investigate complaints, incidents and exceedance of trigger levels; or
 - monitoring the effectiveness of noise and vibration control measures.

Monitoring data and interpretive reports are to be provided to each relevant local authority on a monthly basis and shall include a summary of the construction activities occurring, the data recorded over the monitoring period, any complaints received, any periods in exceedance of agreed trigger levels, the results of any investigations and any actions taken or mitigation measures implemented. This report provides noise data, and interpretation thereof, for monitoring carried out by HS2 within the London Borough of Camden (LBC) for the period 1st to 28th February 2021.

- 1.1.2 Active construction sites in the local authority area where monitoring was undertaken during this period include:
 - The Adelaide Road ventilation shaft, (see plan 2 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - vegetation clearance;
 - trench excavations;
 - installation of hardstanding for laydown areas and temporary haul road;
 - utility diversion works;
 - relocation of dry room;
 - central gate ramp construction;
 - working platform construction; and
 - disconnection of lamp post and installation of three spot lights on hoarding.
 - Euston Throat Retained Cut worksite ref.: ETRC (see plan 2 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - quide wall construction;
 - polymer silo installation and grouting;

- excavations;
- ground compaction; and
- continuous flight auger (CFA) piling and sheet piling.
- Euston Scissor Cut worksite ref.: ESC (see plan 2 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - sheet piling;
 - pile installation;
 - groundworks;
 - installation of pile mat and guide walls;
 - completion of ramp access into the site;
 - surveys along Park Village East at track and street level; and
 - haul road maintenance.
- Hampstead Road Bridge worksite ref.: HRB (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - installation of hoarding and haul road access; and
 - installation of traffic management systems;
 - preparation for removal of bridge and parapet at Granby Terrace Bridge.
- Euston Cavern worksite ref.: ECAV (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - testing of ground anchors;
 - bridge investigations; and
 - hoarding works; and
 - trial of vibratory sheet piling.
- On-Network worksites ref.: B, C, D, E, F, G and H (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - fencing installation (worksite B);
 - overhead line equipment inspections and adjustments, signalling and cabling works (worksites C, D, E, F and G);
 - cable and signal recoveries and drainage works (worksites C, D and E);
 - LED signalhead works (worksite G only);
 - resurfacing works, cutline installation and demolition works (worksites G and H); and
 - erection of an access scaffold under Granby Terrace Bridge (worksite F).
- 140 Hampstead Road and Power Signal Box worksite ref.: S001-WS02 (see plan 2 in Appendix A), where work activities included:

- groundworks (ground remediation); and
- pile cap removal enabling works including preparation of pile mats and minor demolition works.
- Wolfson House, Walkden House, 67-75 & 77-79 Euston Road worksite ref.: S003-WS03 (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - excavation of utilities trenches; and
 - groundworks (backfilling and propping).
- Former National Temperance Hospital, 110 Hampstead Road worksite ref.: S003-WS06 (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - deliveries.
- Former National Temperance Hospital Euston North worksite ref.: NTH-EN (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - clearance of plant and materials;
 - preparation and laying of aggregate material as working platforms for ground investigation equipment and compound; and
 - completion of footpaths and walkways.
- Euston Towers Demolition worksite ref.: ETD (see plan 3 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - site setup; and
 - core drilling to establish depth, position and integrity of existing piles.
- Vehicle Holding Area worksite ref.: VHA (see plan 1 in Appendix A), where work activities included:
 - steel fixing of concrete slabs;
 - concrete pouring; and
 - site setup.
- 1.1.3 Further works, where monitoring did not take place, were also undertaken at the following locations:
 - Hampstead Road, Stephenson Way, Melton Street, North Gower Street, Ragnart Buildings and Harrington Street, where utilities works were undertaken.
 - Interim Taxi Rank worksite where work activities included ground load bearing testing, construction of concrete crossovers, tree removal and waste clearance, establishment of welfare compound and site setup.

1.1.4 The applicable standards, guidance, and monitoring methodology is outlined in the construction noise and vibration monitoring methodology report which can be found at the following location https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/monitoring-the-environmental-effects-of-hs2. 1.2 Measurement Locations

- 1.2.1 Thirty-two (32) noise and seven (7) vibration monitoring installations were active across twelve (12) worksites in February in the LBC area. Table 2 summarises the position of noise and vibration monitoring installations within the LBC area in February 2021.
- 1.2.2 Due to a coupling issue at the interface between vibration monitor V039 and the ground no valid data was collected at this location in February 2021.
- 1.2.3 Maps showing the position of noise and vibration monitoring installations are presented in Appendix B.

2 Summary of Results

2.1 Summary of Measured Noise and Vibration Levels

2.1.3 Appendix C presents graphs of the noise and vibration monitoring data over the month for each of the measurement locations. 2.2 Exceedances of the SOAEL

- 2.2.1 The significant observed adverse effect level (SOAEL) is defined in the 'Planning Practice Guidance Noise' as the level above which "noise causes a material change in behaviour and/or attitude, e.g. avoiding certain activities during periods of intrusion; where there is no alternative ventilation, having to keep windows closed most of the time because of the noise. Potential for sleep disturbance resulting in difficulty in getting to sleep, premature awakening and difficulty in getting back to sleep. Quality of life diminished due to change in acoustic character of the area."
- 2.2.2 HS2 Phase One Information Paper E23: Control of Construction Noise and Vibration sets out the SOAELs for construction noise.
- 2.2.3 Where construction noise levels exceed the SOAEL, relevant periods will be identified, and summary statistics provided in order to evaluate ongoing qualification for noise insulation and temporary rehousing.

2.2.4 Table 5 presents a summary of recorded exceedances of the SOAEL at each measurement location over the reporting period, including the number of exceedances during each time period.

2.2.5 For the purpose of assessing eligibility for noise insulation or temporary rehousing, multiple exceedances of the SOAEL in a 24-hour period would be counted as a single exceedance during that day. Over the reporting period, the overall number of SOAEL exceedances at each measurement location is shown in Table 6 and may be lower than the total sum of individual exceedances reported in Table 5 for each location.









Worksite identification plan - Overview




