## JUDGMENT

The Respondent was in breach of contract by:

- i) dismissing the Claimant without giving him six months' notice of the termination,
- ii) failing to pay to the Claimant his salary for a period from 1 September to 2 October 2020,
- iii) failing to make pension contributions for a period from 1 September to 2 October 2020,
- iv) failing to pay to the Claimant for his accrued but untaken holidays, and
- v) failing to reimburse the Claimant for his business expenses

and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of **£25,000**, being damages for the breach of contract.
