IV. HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned, certify that:

- (a) the petfood has been manufactured entirely in the United Kingdom, in a manufacturing facility approved and monitored by the competent veterinary authority of the United Kingdom in accordance with European Union legislation;
- (b) the pet food contains animal protein derived from healthy *fish, *poultry, *cattle, *goats, *sheep, *deer, *swine or *buffalo and not from diseased animals or animals which died from infection or a disease outbreak;
- (c) pet food intended for cats does not contain pork or swine origin ingredients;
- (d) the petfood does not contain any meat derived from animals affected or suspected of being affected with bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) or scrapie;
- (e) the UK is recognised as having a controlled BSE risk in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Code;
- (f) specified risk materials (SRM) are removed from bovine, ovine and caprine animals slaughtered in the UK according to the recommendations of the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE);
- (g) there has been no outbreak of foot and mouth disease (FMD) or Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) within a 10 km radius of the manufacturing facility;
- (h) the pet food referred in the certificate has been subjected to the following method of sterilisation, or any other equivalent methods that would ensure destructions of HPAI virus;
- (i) the pet food has been manufactured according to standard processing techniques and has been subjected to heat treatment to reach an internal core temperature of at least 70°C for a period of not less than 30 minutes or to any equivalent treatment which has been demonstrated to kill virus and bacteria;

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- (j) all reasonable precautions have been taken to prevent contamination of the petfood by pathogens and other harmful material;
- (k) the products were packed and sealed directly into sterilized airtight packing/bags at the manufacturing plant;
- (l) the petfood is safe and fit for animal consumption.
