#### Spending Review update

The Chair thanked members for their responses to his letter requesting Spending Review R&D bid summary information relating to delivering net zero. The Board reviewed the overall bids and noted the good level of joint working already between Board members on these. The Board considered how the information could assist with its oversight role should further prioritisation or trade-offs be required.

#### Net Zero R&D Delivery Plan

The Board received an update on the drafting of the UK Net Zero R&D Delivery Plan. The Board recommended that the plan should take a systems approach, considered international research and development efforts and consider aspects of behaviour change related to the technology innovation. The Board agreed the general direction of the plan and requested a further update at the next meeting.

## Ofgem Innovation Funding

The Board received an update from Ofgem on their Strategic Innovation Fund and plans for closer co-operation and alignment with relevant Government research and innovation programmes. The Board welcomed the proposals and agreed that further cooperation should continue.
