JUDGMENT - REMEDY

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed by the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the following:

Basic award:	£738.69
Loss of statutory rights:	£500
Compensatory award:	£5,674.80
Total:	£6,913.49

- 2. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to the Claimant in the sum of £471.00.
- 3. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1,378.88
- 4. The Respondent has not made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages.

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5. The total sum that the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant is £8,763.37
