The Employment Tribunal, in accordance with Rule 64 of the *Employment Tribunal (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, Schedule 1* issues the following Judgment of consent of parties:

- 1) The First Respondent shall pay to the Claimant, Mrs Helen Webster the following sums namely:
 - a) Compensation for unlawful deduction of wages claim of unpaid wages for the period 1st September 2019 to 15th November 2019 in the sum of THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS (£31,500) gross and payment in relation to the breach of contract claim, of unpaid

employer pension contributions, in the sum of NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SEVEN POUNDS AND FIFTY PENCE (£937.50) gross.

5 2) The claim against the Second Respondent, having been withdrawn by the claimant is dismissed under Rule 52 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the *Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013*.

10 3) There shall be no order as to expenses, wasted costs or preparation time.

4) The second day of the hearing listed on 5th March 2021 be vacated.
