


North East COVID-19 cases: 08 Apr to 14 Apr 2021 Weekly case rates per 100,000 population by local authority

North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 22 Mar to 14 Apr 2021





North East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 22 Mar to 14 Apr 2021







County Durham case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 Apr 2021




Darlington case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 **Apr 2021**


Gateshead case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 **Apr 2021**




Middlesbrough case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 Apr 2021








Redcar and Cleveland case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 Apr 2021






South Tyneside case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 Apr 2021



Stockton-on-Tees case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 18 Apr 2021




Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Stockton-on-Tees: 22 Mar to 18 Apr 2021
