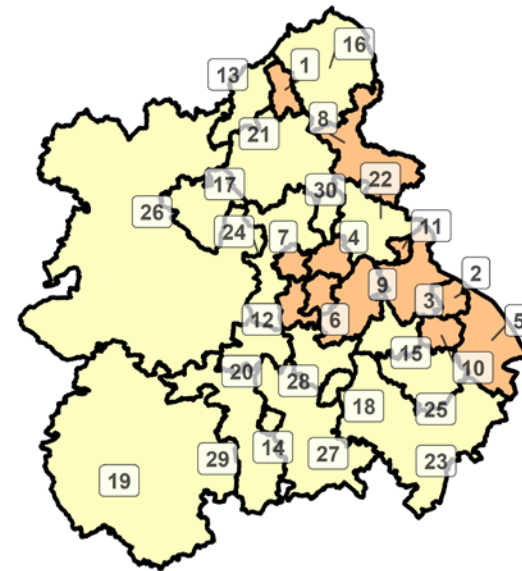

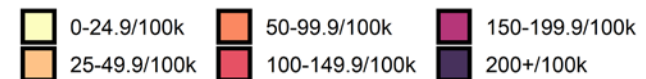

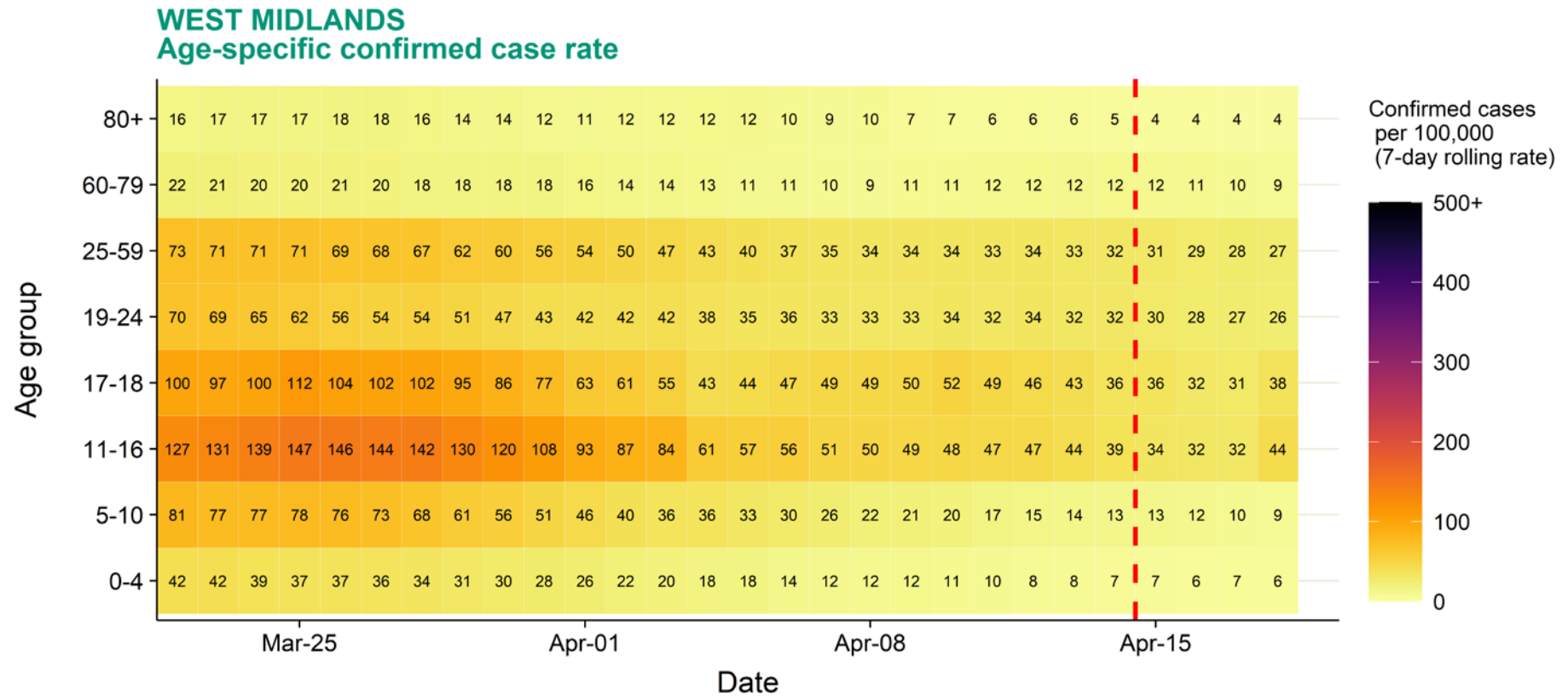
Covid-19 rate by local authority

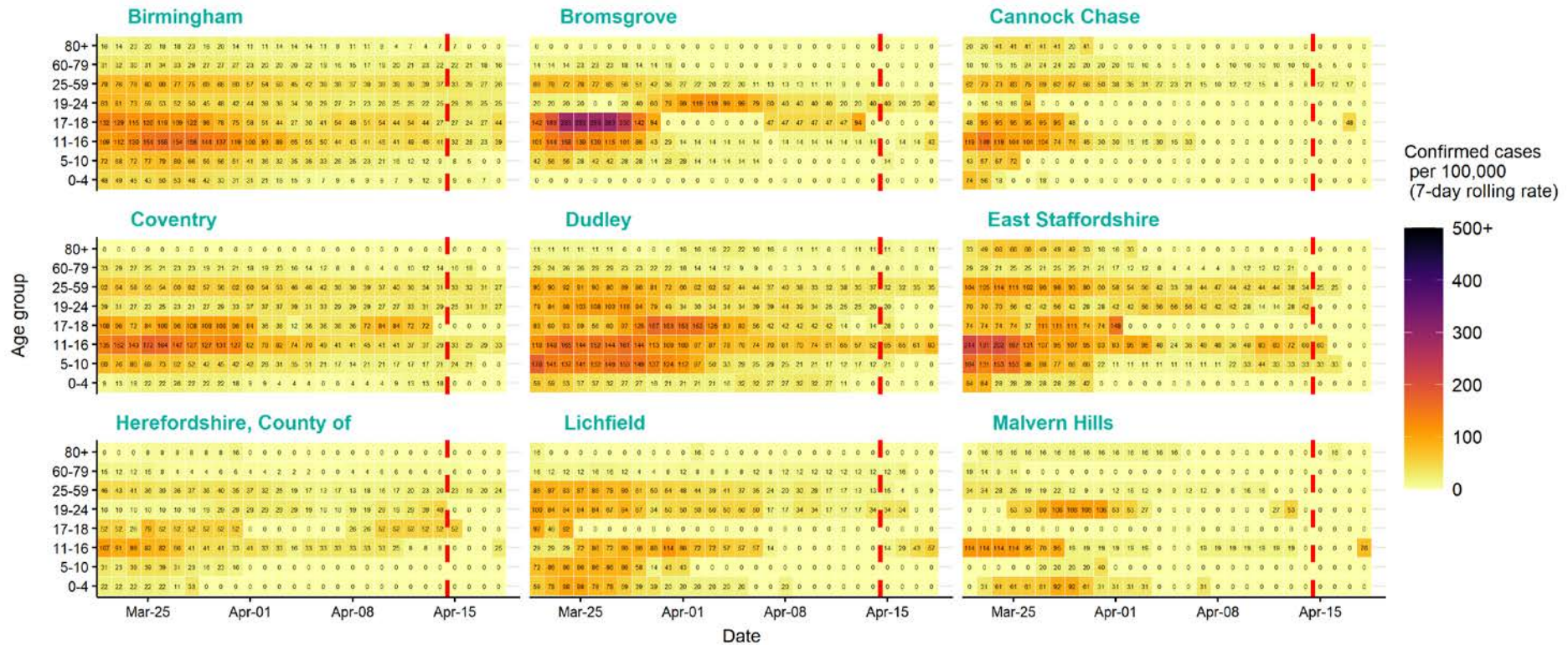

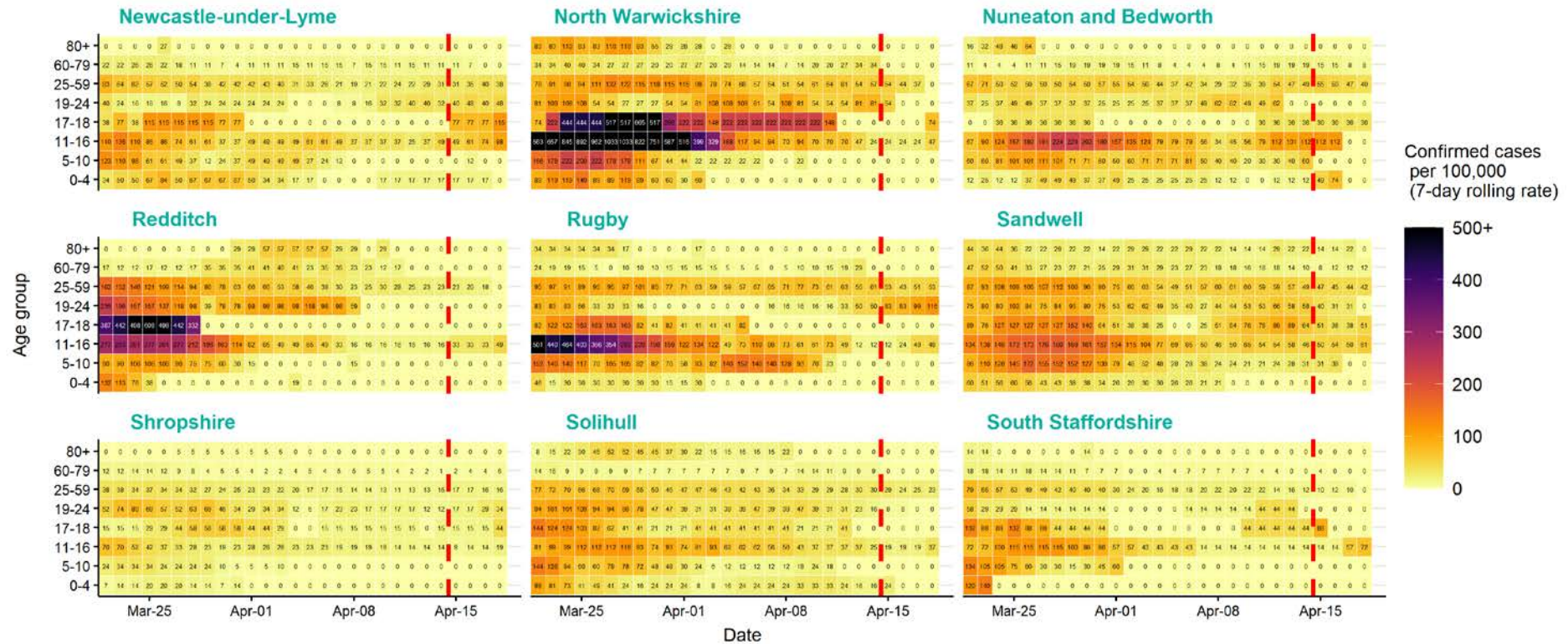

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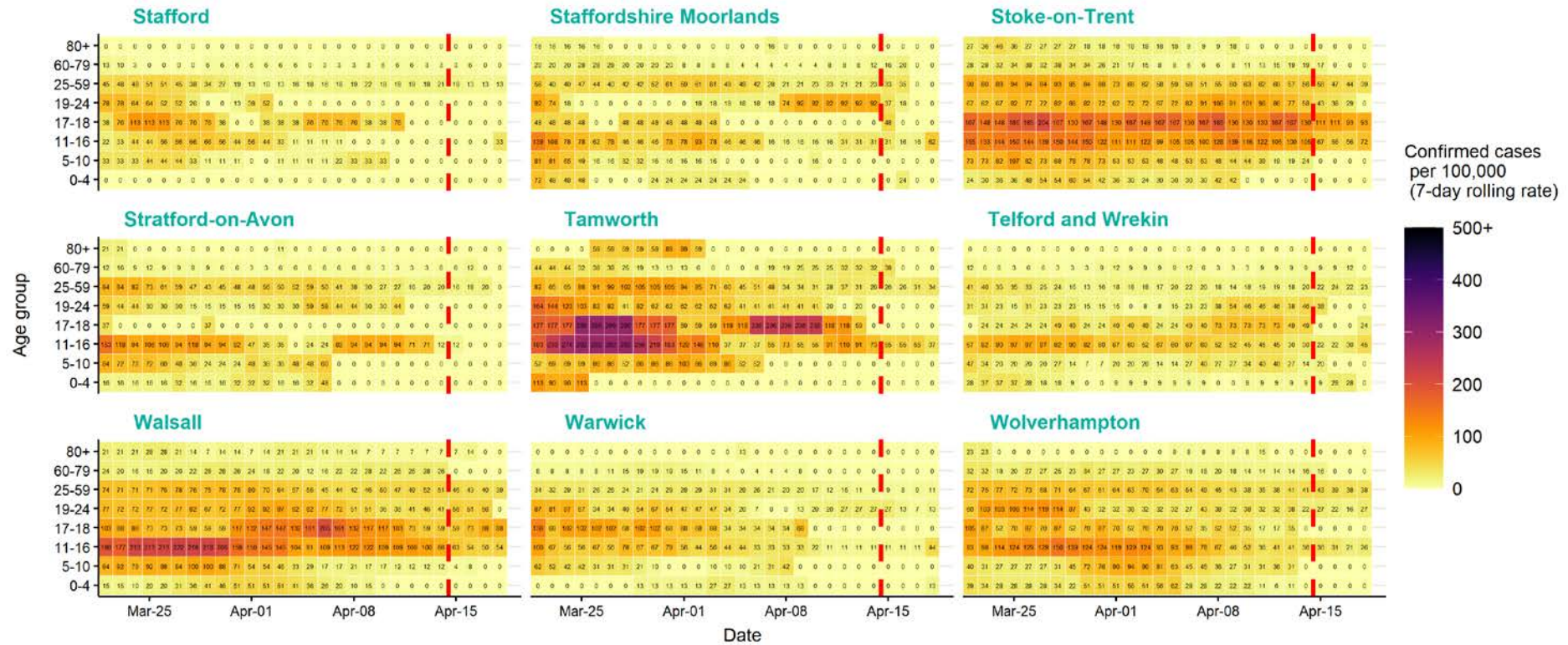

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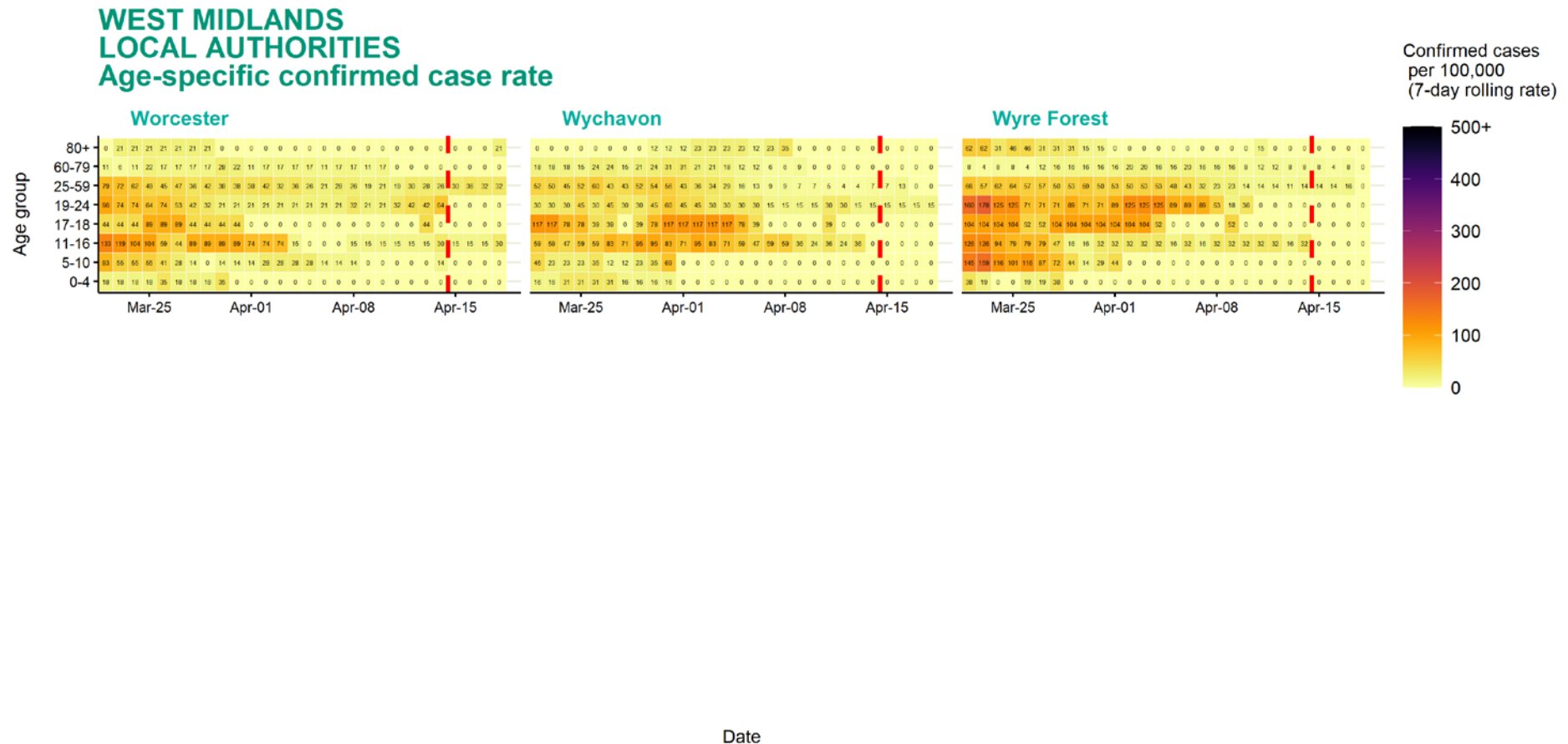

West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 22 Mar to 14 Apr 2021



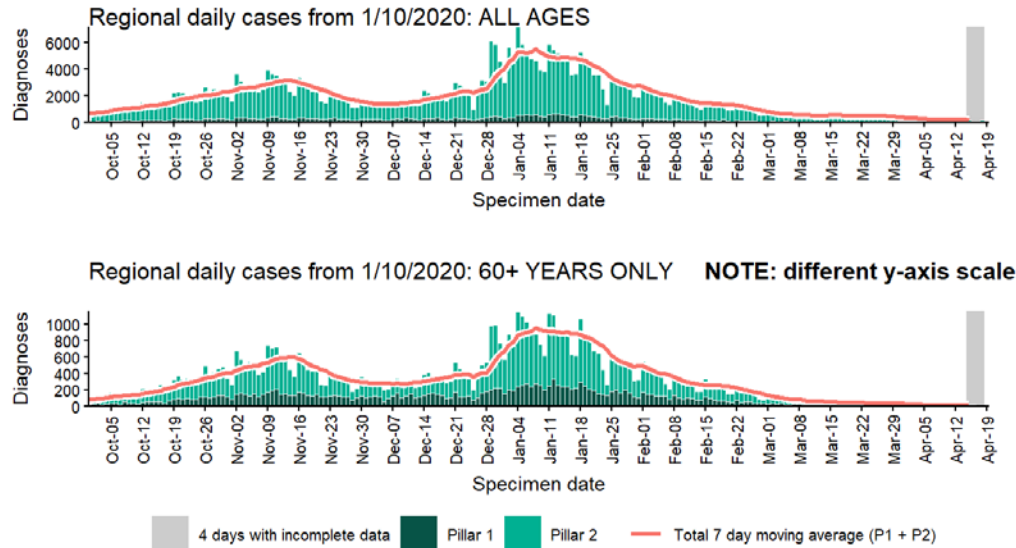

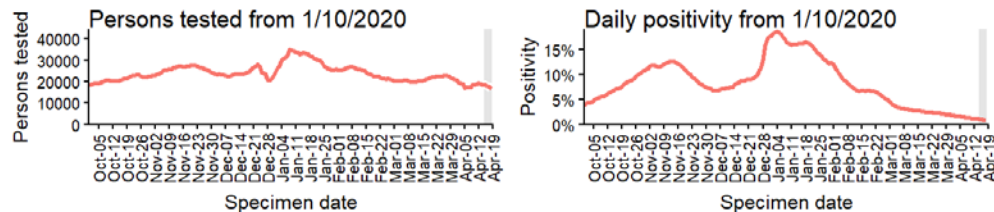

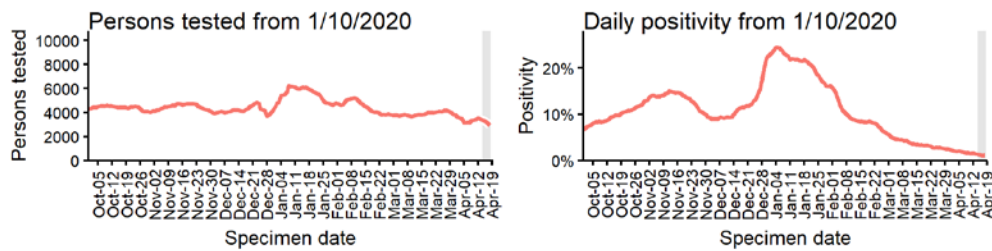
