## JUDGMENT ON LIABILITY

The unanimous decision of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's claim of discrimination because of something arising as a consequence of a disability under section 15 of the Equality Act 2010 ("EA") fails.
- 2. The claimant's claim of victimisation under section 27(of the EA fails.
- 3. The claimant's claim that the respondent failed to comply with its duty to make reasonable adjustments under sections 20, 21 and s.39(5) of the EA fails.
- 4. The claimant's claims that she was harassed by the respondent related to her disability under section 26 of the EA fails.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, any other claim made or intimated by the claimant in her original application or during the course of these proceedings are dismissed upon withdrawal.

Note: This has been a remote hearing. The parties did not object to the case being heard remotely. The form of remote hearing was V - video. It was not practicable to hold a face to face hearing because of the Covid19 pandemic.
