JUDGMENT AT A REMEDY HEARING

A face to face hearing was not held it was not practicable and all issues could be determined in a remote hearing. The order made is described below.
2. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant damages for breach of contract assessed in the net sum of **£5,642** in respect of unpaid wages for work performed between 4 May and 4 July 2020.
3. The Claimant's claims of breach of contract in respect of unpaid rent is dismissed because the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider it.
