





Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 29 Mar to 21 Apr 2021









Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 29 Mar to 21 Apr 2021














Bradford case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021










Calderdale case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021










Craven case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021



















East Riding of Yorkshire case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021















Age-stratified case rate heatmap for East Riding of Yorkshire: 29 Mar to 25 Apr 2021

















Kirklees case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021









Leeds case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021




Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Leeds: 29 Mar to 25 Apr 2021




North East Lincolnshire case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021












Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Richmondshire: 29 Mar to 25 Apr 2021











Selby case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021





Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Selby: 29 Mar to 25 Apr 2021











Wakefield case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021








York case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 25 Apr 2021
