JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave judgment as follows:-

- 1. The Respondent's application that the allegations or complaints relied on by the Claimant should be struck out because they are out of time is refused.
- 2. The Respondent's application that allegations one, five and nine should be subject to payment of a deposit by the Claimant because they have little reasonable prospect of success is refused.
- 3. The Claimant's application to amend her claim to include an allegation of direct disability discrimination that the Respondent "*implemented weekly meetings*" as per allegation one of the Scott Schedule is allowed.
