Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 - Section 53
NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
Downgrading of Public Bridleway No. 05.26/37 to Footpath, Nutgill Farm,
Ingleton - Modification Order 2009

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **09 March 2021**

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be **to modify**:

The definitive map and statement for the area by downgrading the public bridleway to a public footpath. Commencing on the road south-south-east of Nutgill Farm and proceeds generally north-east for approximately 89 metres, then turns and proceeds north for approximately 15 metres to north-west corner of building, then turns in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 167 metres, then turns and proceeds in a generally north-north-easterly direction for approximately 64 metres, then proceeds in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 62 metres, then proceeds in a generally northerly direction for approximately 288 metres to the junction with Langber End Lane.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 23 March 2021]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send

a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 04 May 2021]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation or any other person wishing to make representations in writing must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 15 June 2021]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

We cannot accept any inflammatory, discriminatory, or abusive comments. Any documents containing such comments will be returned.

MODIFICATION ORDER 2009

This Order is made by North Yorkshire County Council under Section 53(2)(a) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the District of Craven (Outside the Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. North Yorkshire County Council hereby order that:-

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 15 December 2009.
2. The District of Craven (Outside the Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "Downgrading of Public Bridleway No 05.26/37 to Footpath, Nutgill Farm, Ingleton Modification Order 2009".

Commences at Grid Reference 36929 47036 (Point A) south-south-east of Nutgill Farm and proceeds generally north east for approximately 74 metres to Grid Reference 36934 47042 (Point B), then turns and proceeds north for approximately 15 metres to the north west corner of a building at Grid Reference 36934 47043 (Point C), then turns in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 167 metres to Grid Reference 36929 47058 (Point D), then turns and proceeds in a generally north-north-easterly direction for approximately 64 metres to Grid Reference 36930 47065 (Point E), then proceeds in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 62 metres to Grid Reference 36934 47069 (Point F), then proceeds in a generally northerly direction for approximately 288 metres to the junction with Langber End Lane at Grid Reference 36934 47099 (Point G).

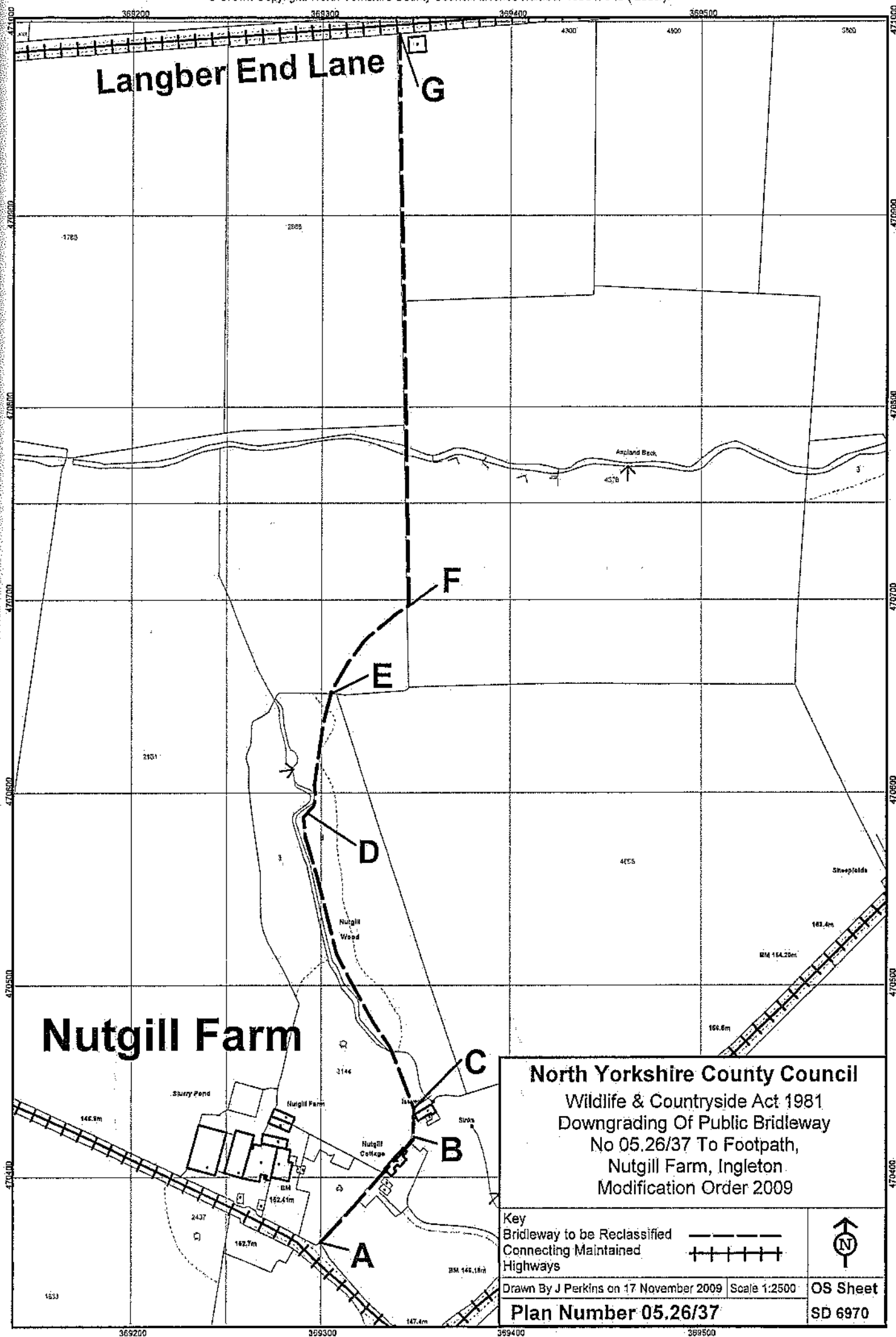

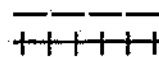
