JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant was an employee of the Respondent for the purposes of *section 230 Employment Rights Act 1996*.
- 2. The Claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment under section 135 (1)(a) Employment Rights Act 1996 is well founded and succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £854.22.
- 3. The Claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £250.00 as follows:
 - a. *Basic award:* There is no basic award in lieu of the award for the statutory redundancy payment; and
 - b. Compensatory award: £250.00 for loss of statutory rights.
- 4. The Claimant's complaint of wrongful dismissal is well founded and succeeds and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant as compensation for wrongful dismissal the sum of £854.22 (to be paid net after deductions for tax and national insurance).

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5.	The Respondent shall pay the Claimant additional compensation of two weeks' pay totalling £287.74 pursuant to section 38 Employment Act 2002 for failure by the Respondent to provide the Claimant with a written statement of employment particulars.
