




West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 6 Apr to 29 Apr 2021











Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Dudley: 6 Apr to 3 May 2021














Malvern Hills case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 3 May 2021















Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Rugby: 6 Apr to 3 May 2021






Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Walsall: 6 Apr to 3 May 2021









Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Warwick: 6 Apr to 3 May 2021














Worcester case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 3 May 2021









Wychavon case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 3 May 2021




