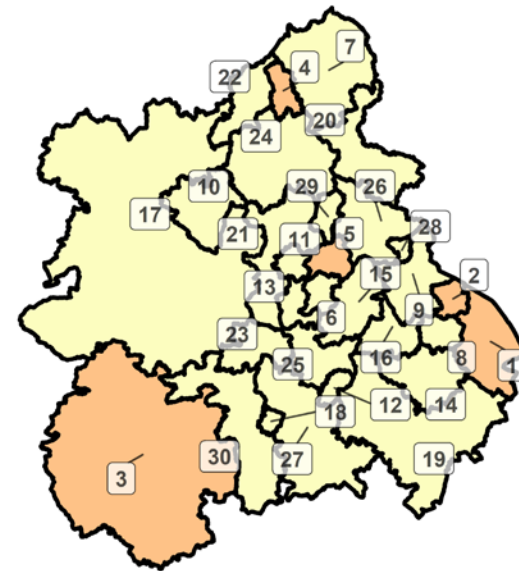

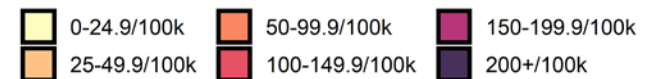

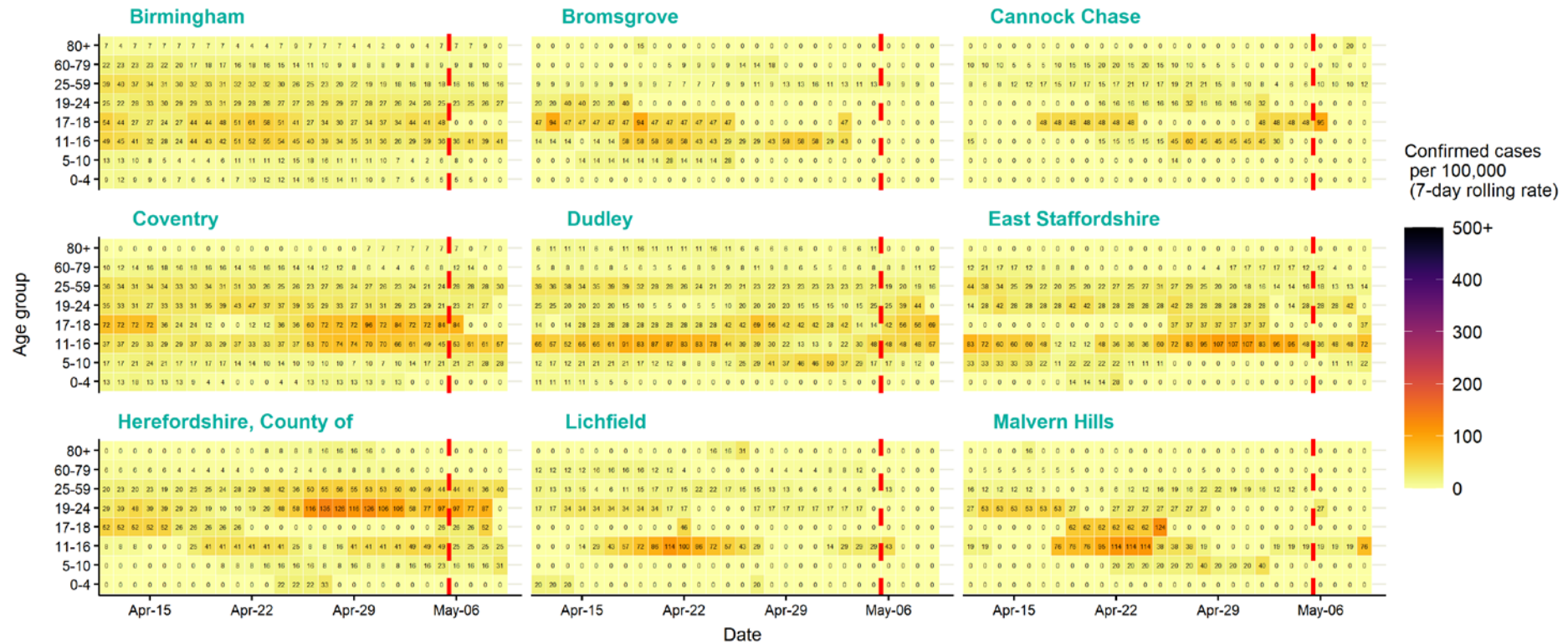

WEST MIDLANDS LOCAL AUTHORITIES Age-specific confirmed case rate



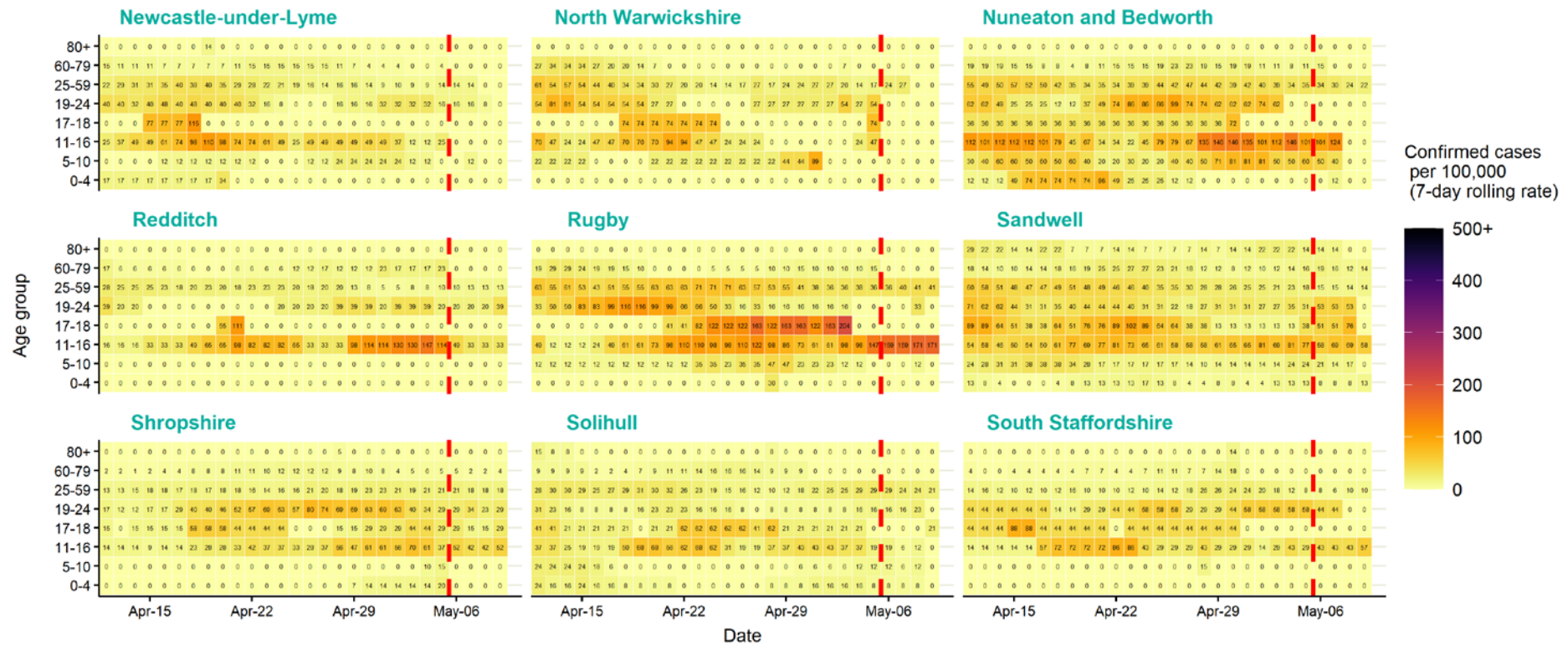

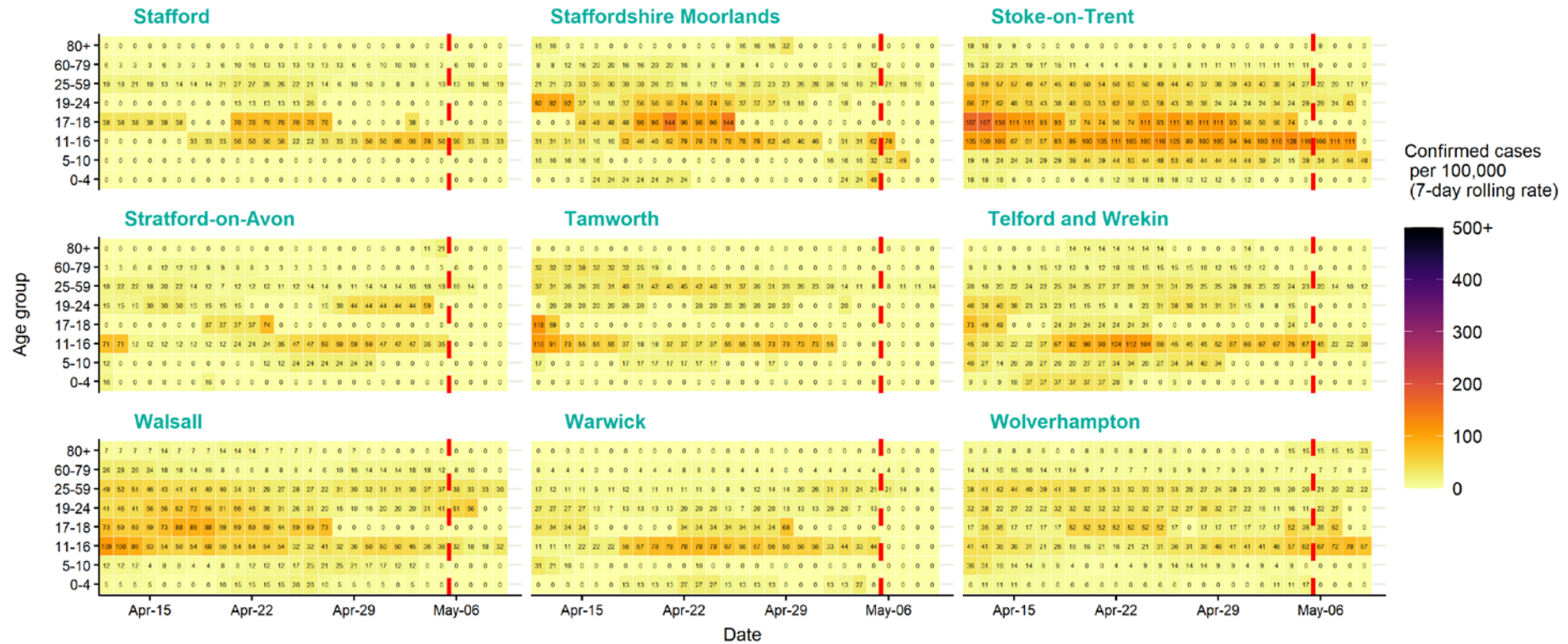

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West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 12 Apr to 5 May 2021

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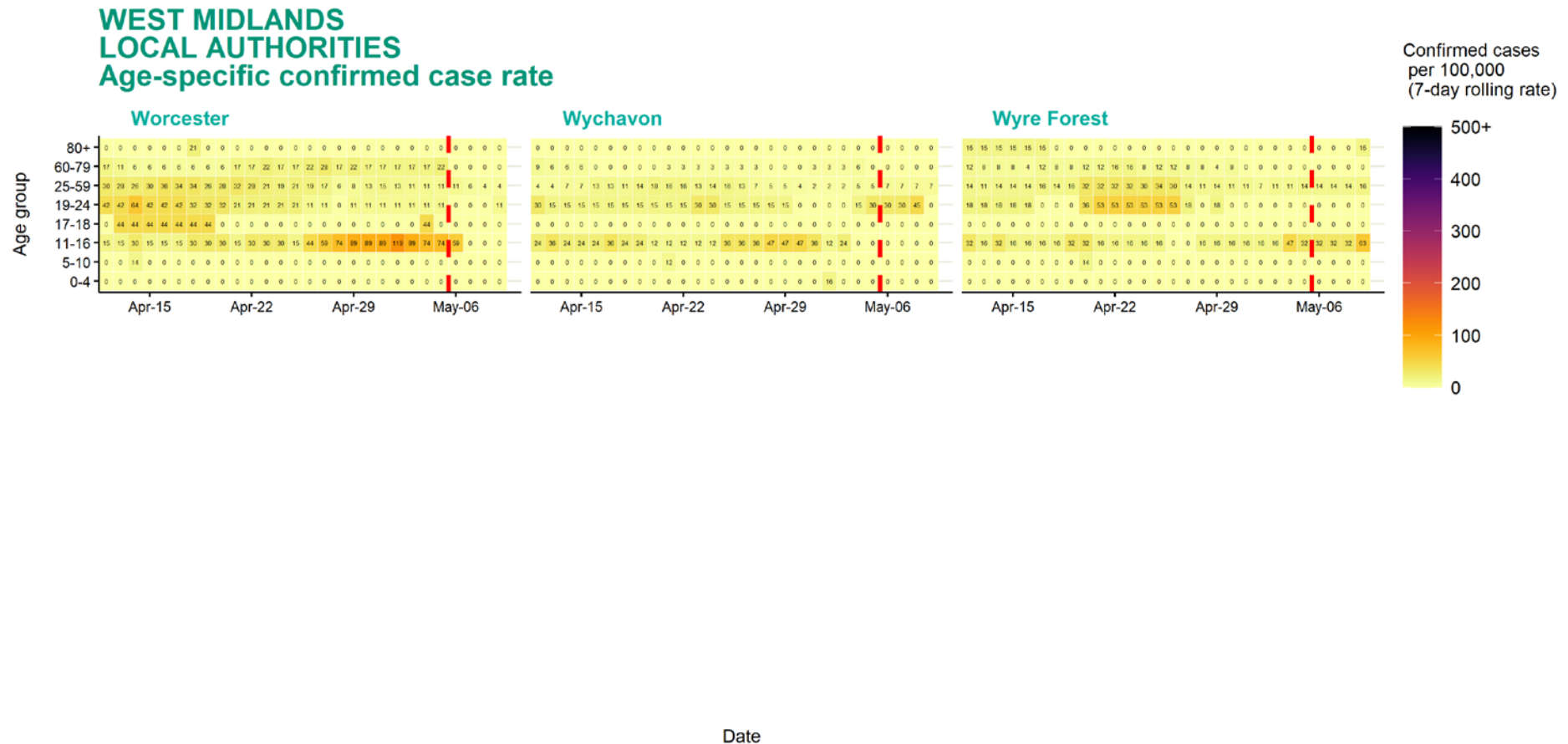

West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 12 Apr to 5 May 2021



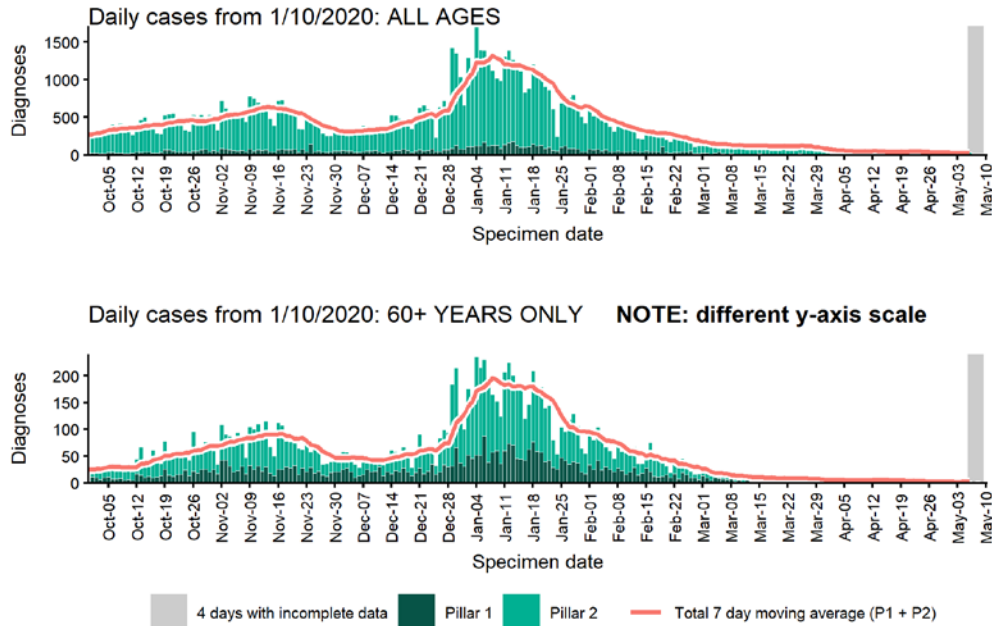

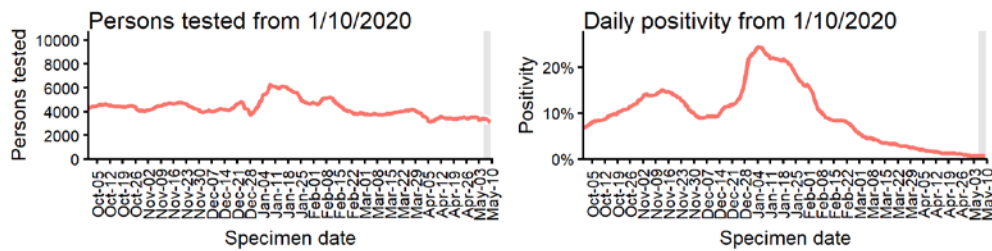

Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Cannock Chase: 12 Apr to 9 May 2021

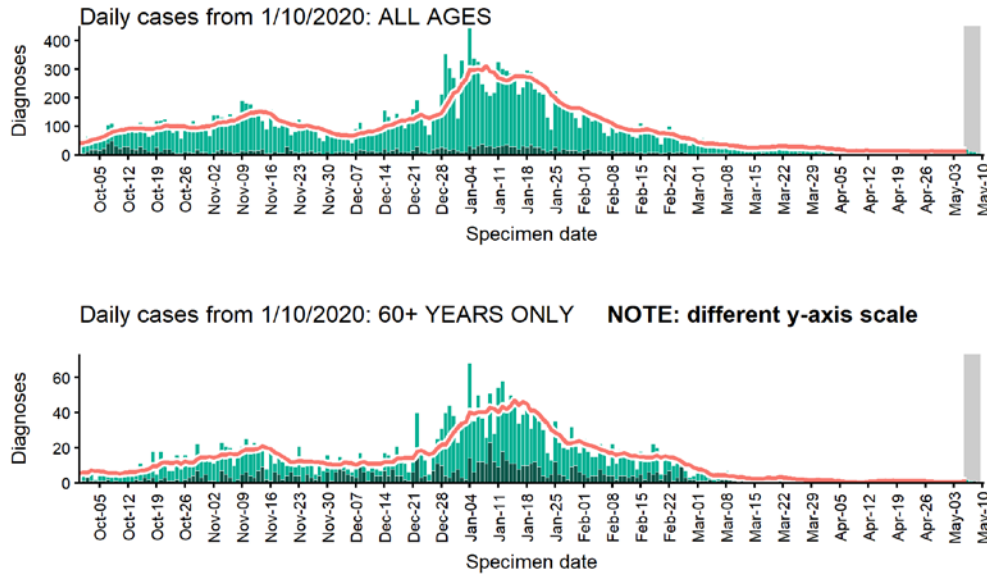

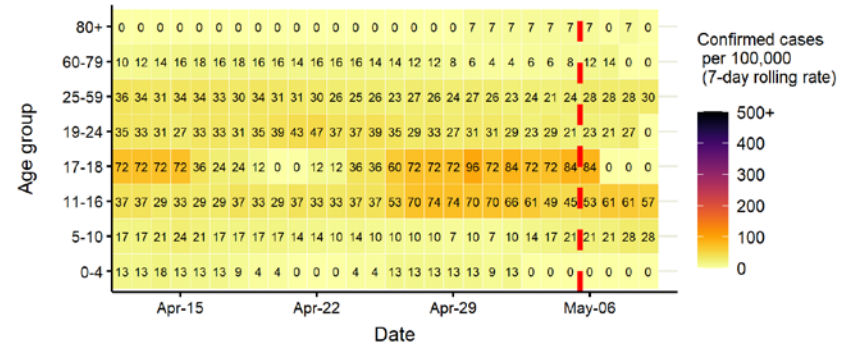

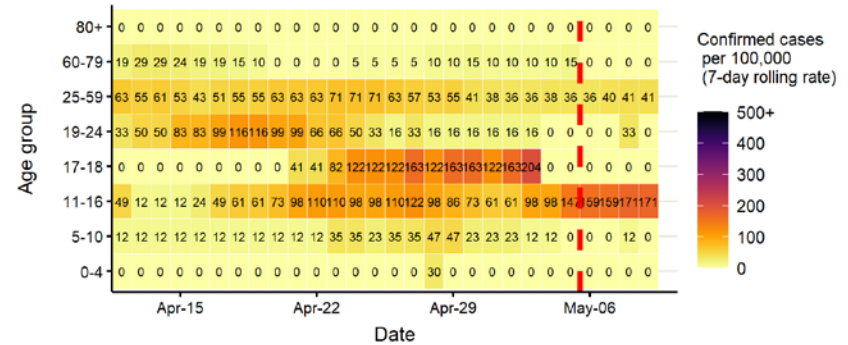

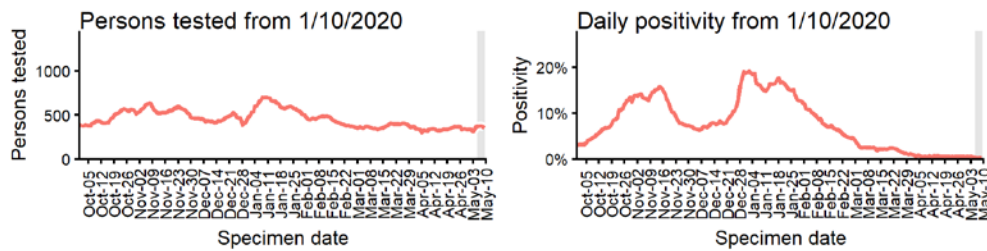

Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Stafford: 12 Apr to 9 May 2021



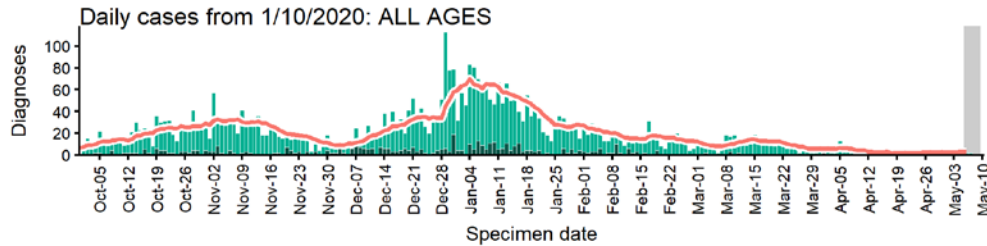

Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Warwick: 12 Apr to 9 May 2021



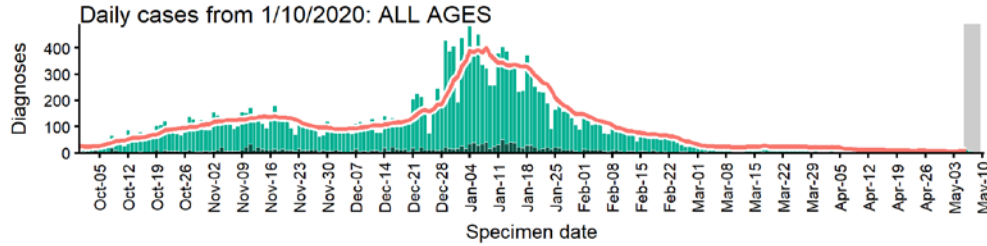

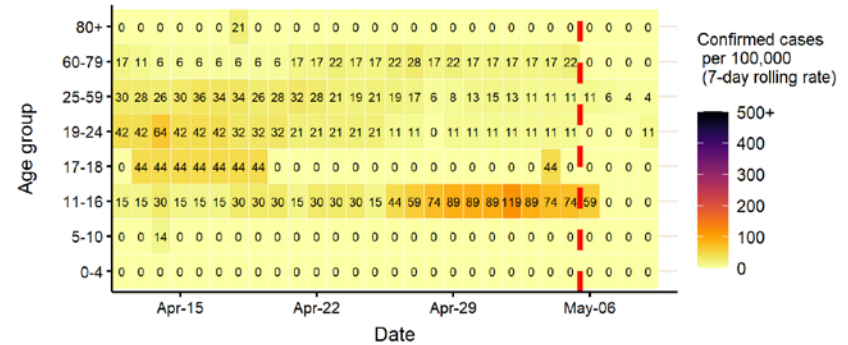

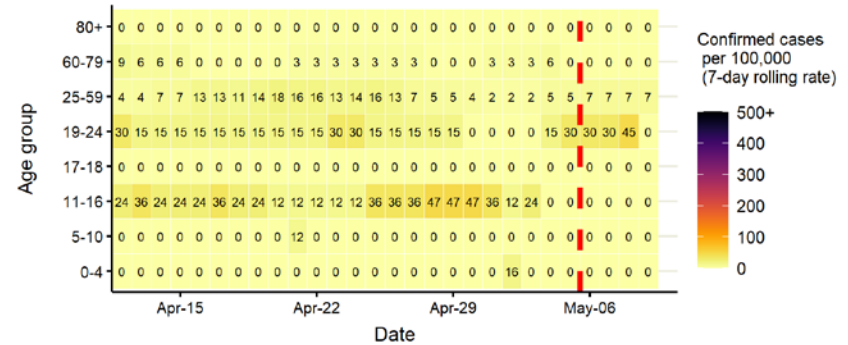

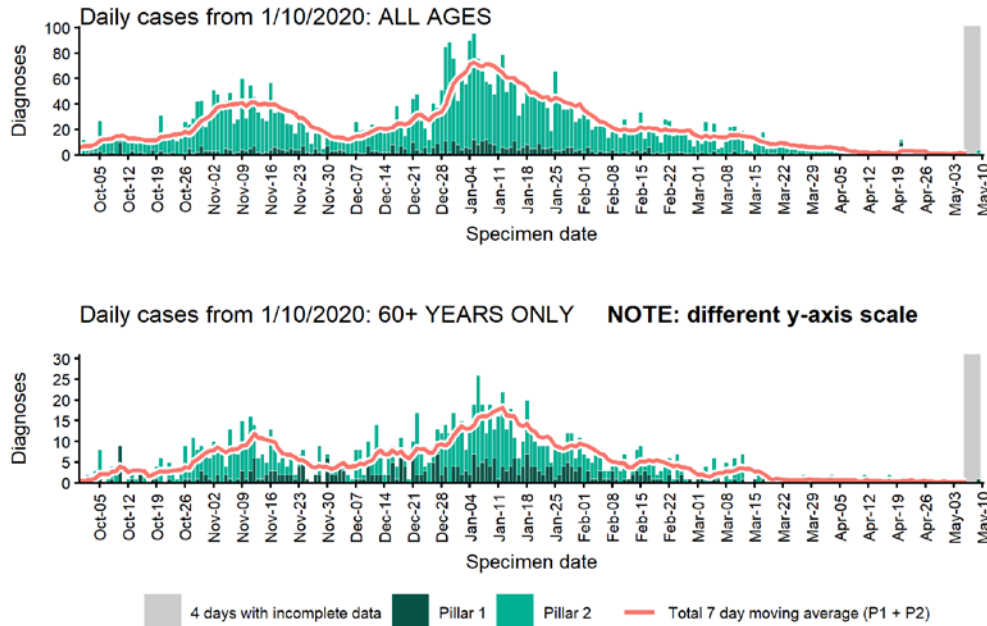

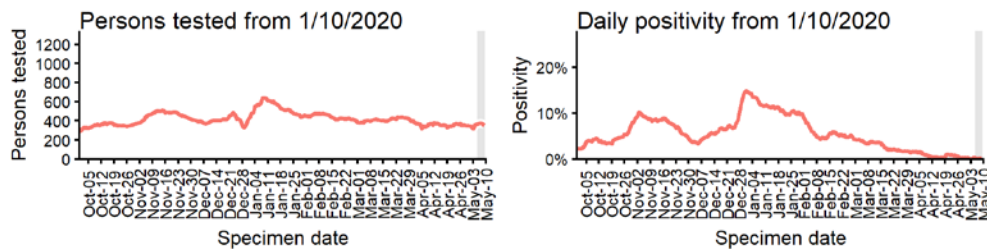
