




East Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 19 Apr to 12 May 2021
















Bassetlaw case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 16 May 2021














Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Blaby: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021









Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Derby: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021






Age-stratified case rate heatmap for North West Leicestershire: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021




