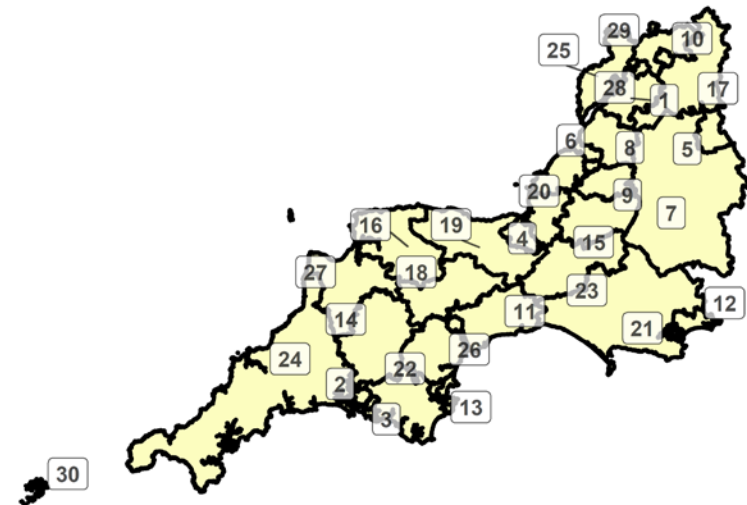

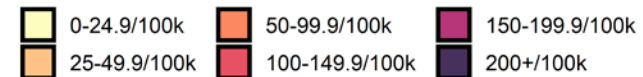

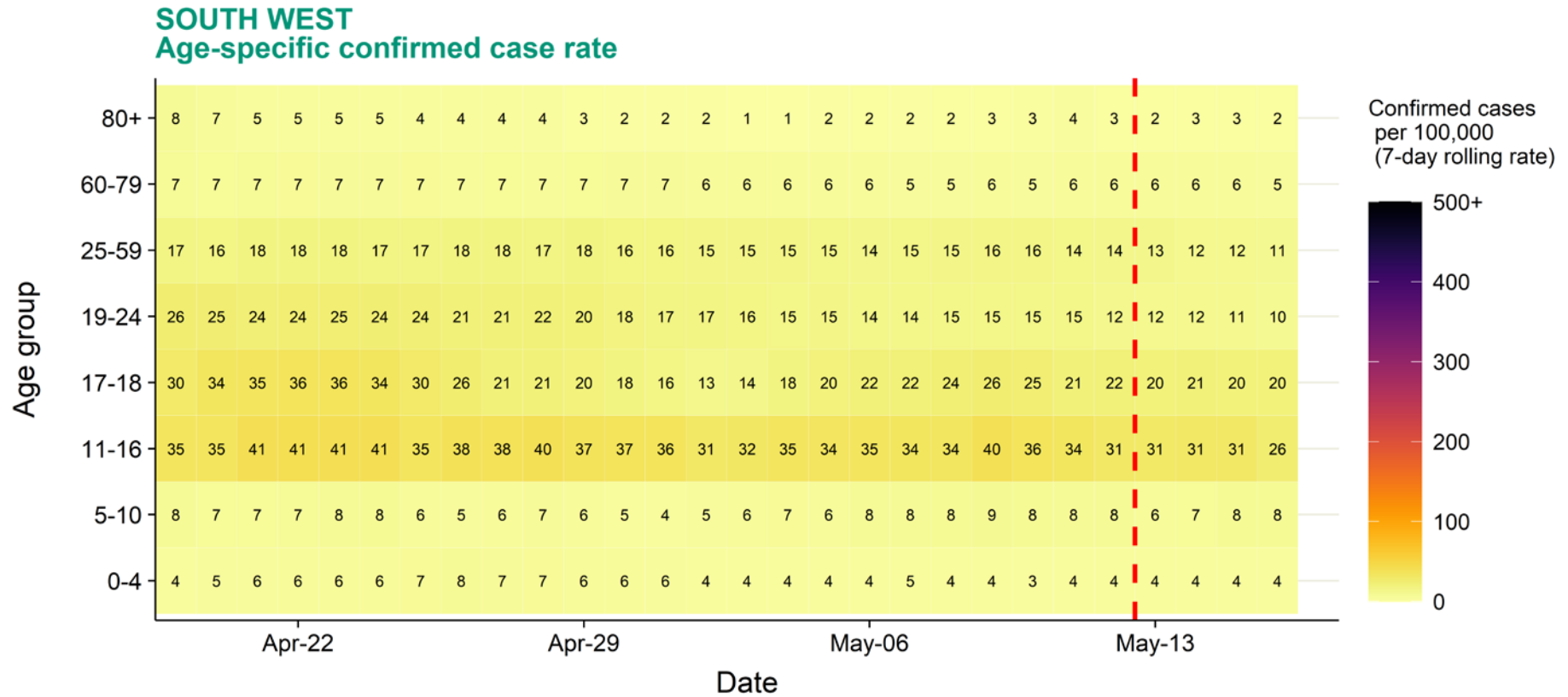
Covid-19 rate by local authority

South West age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 19 Apr to 12 May 2021



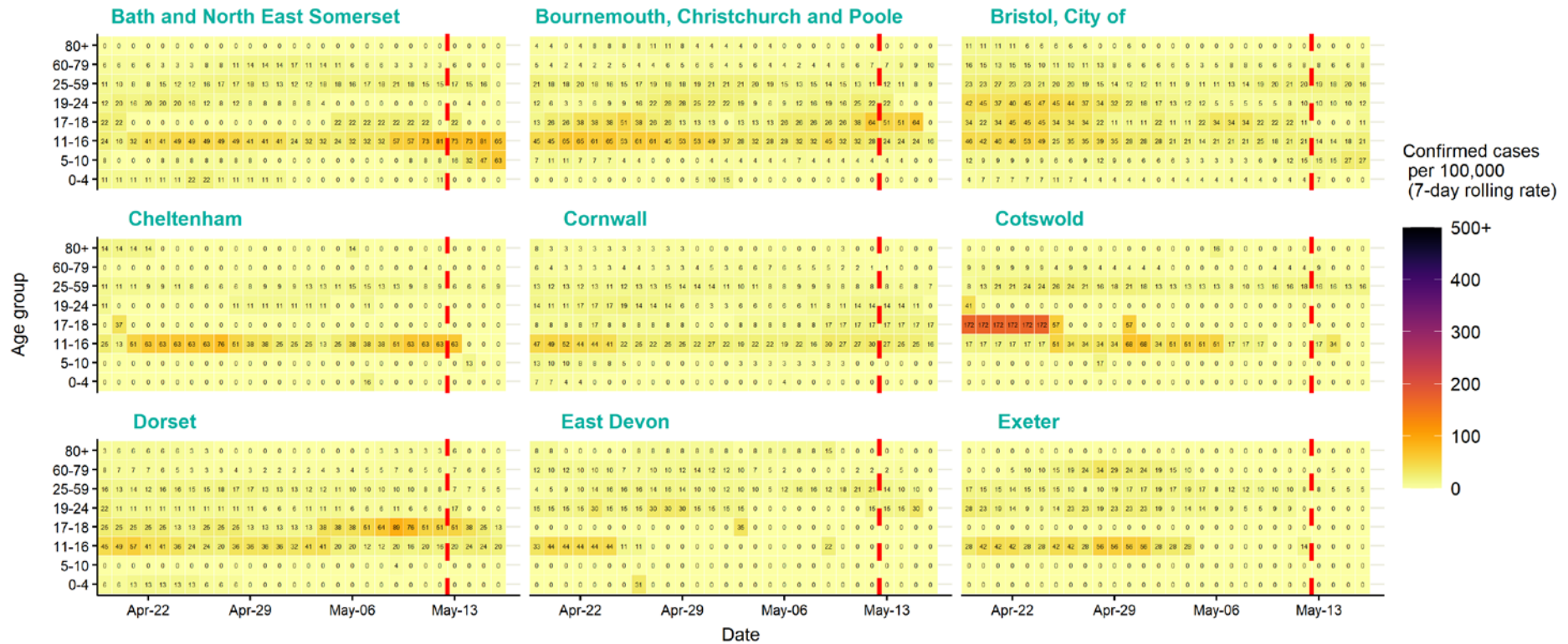

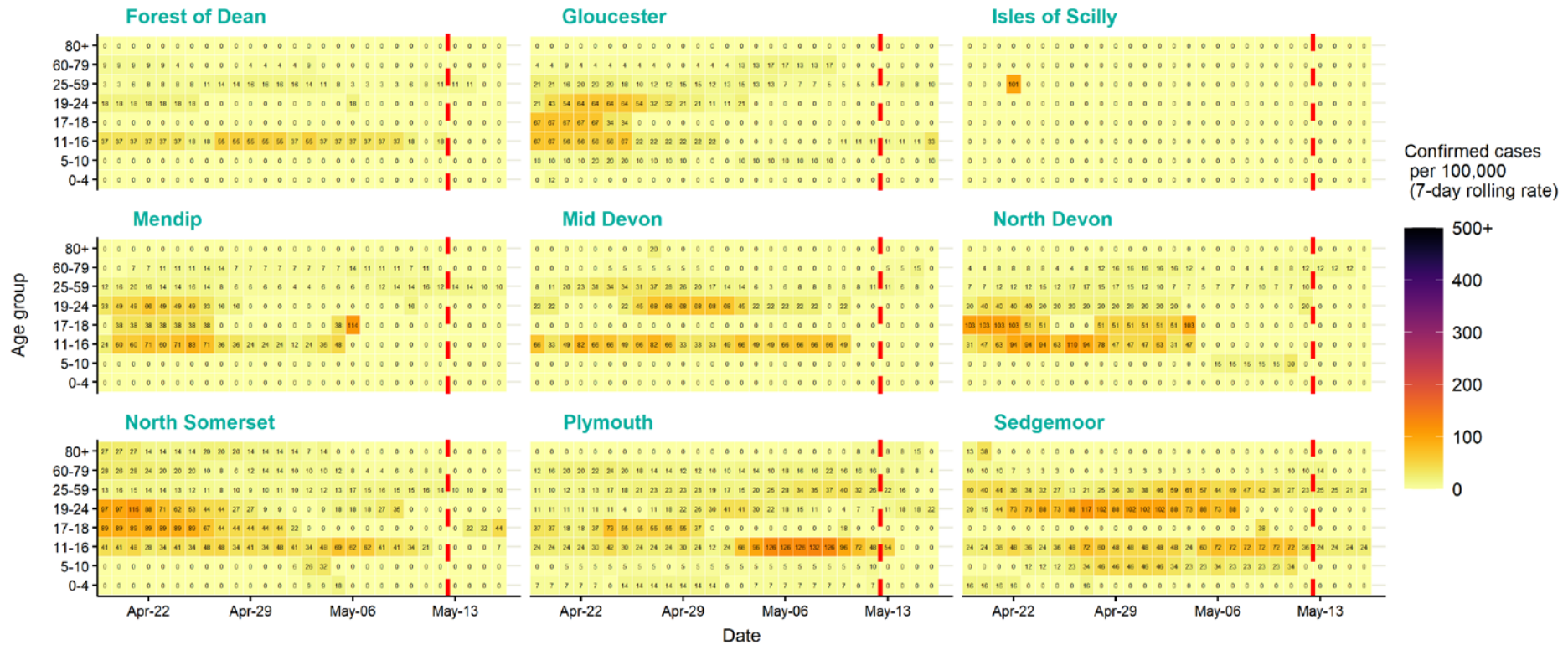

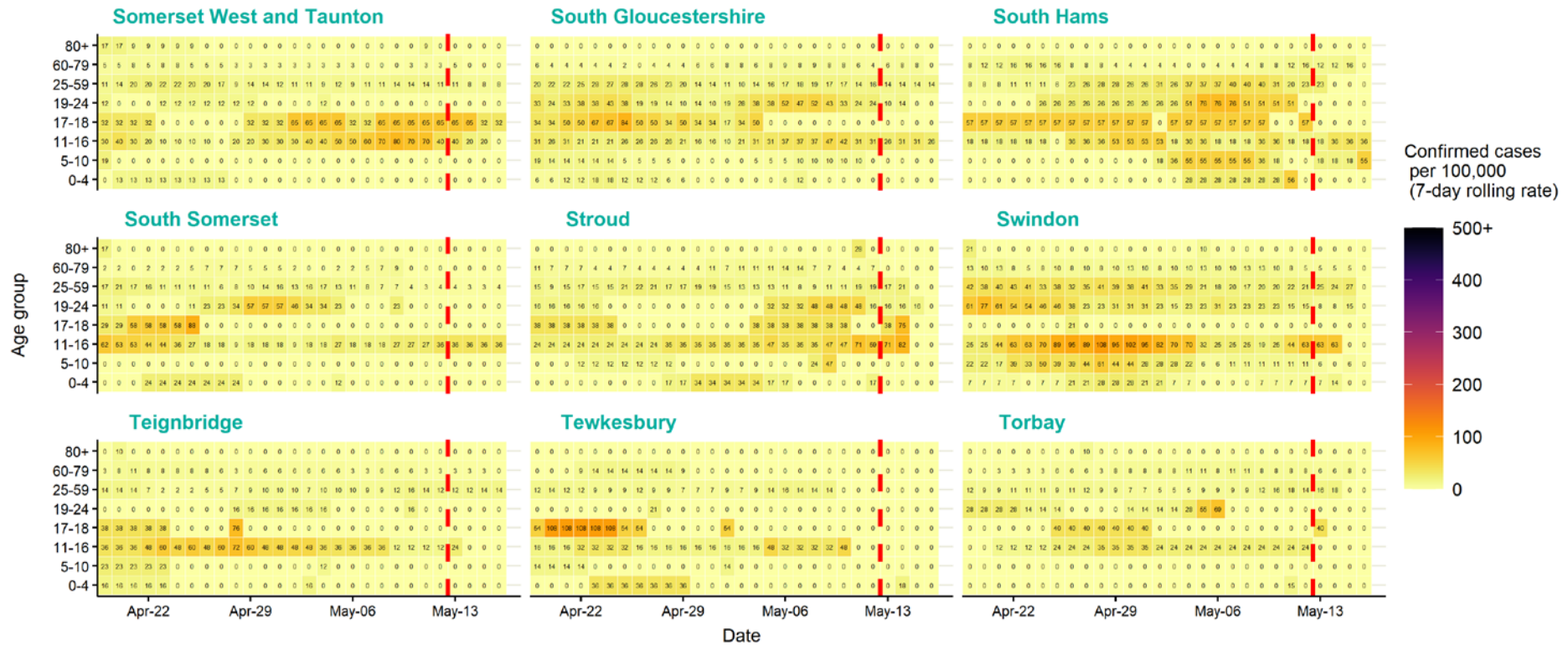

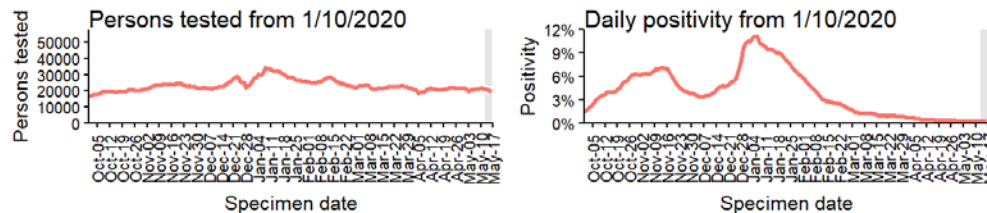
