




West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 19 Apr to 12 May 2021














Age-stratified case rate heatmap for North Warwickshire: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021






Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Rugby: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021




