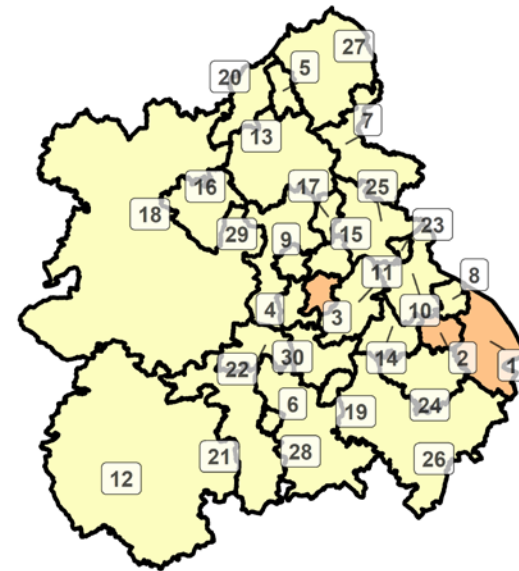

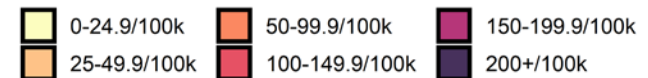

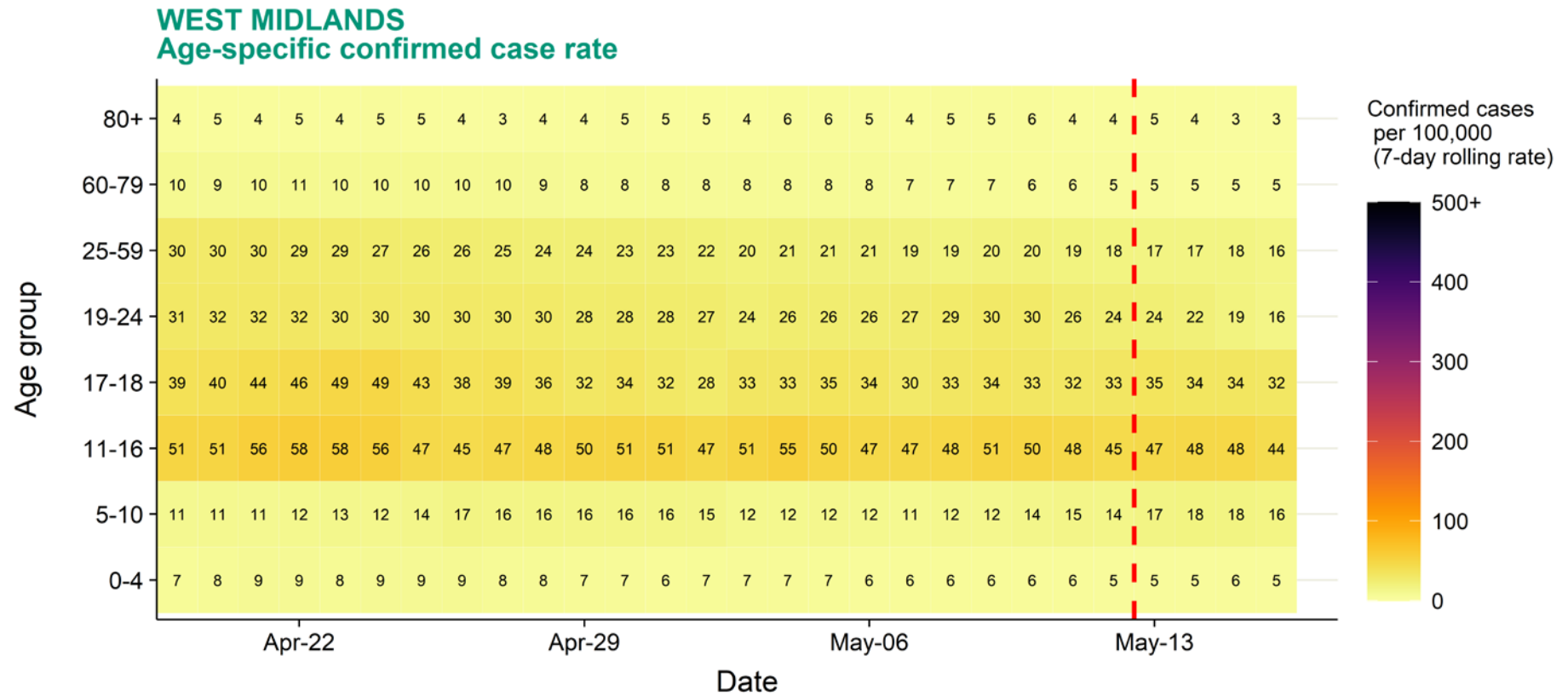
Covid-19 rate by local authority

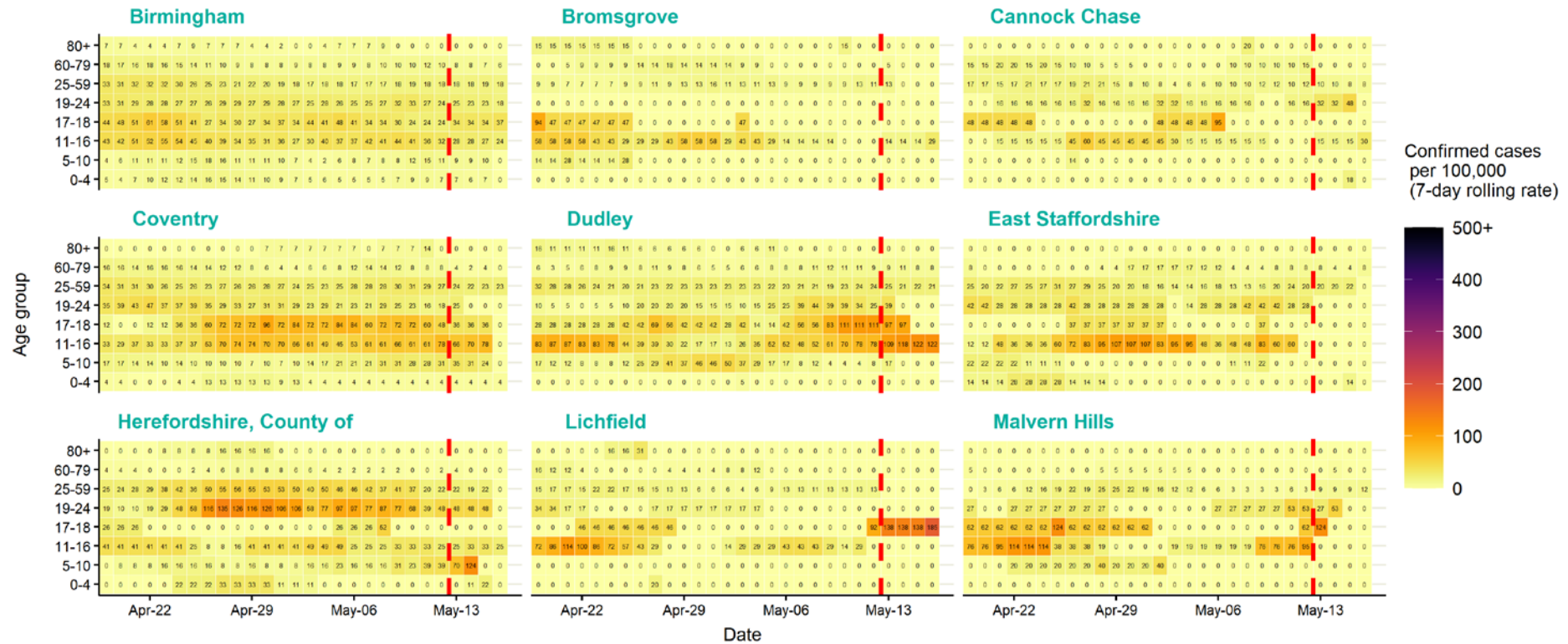

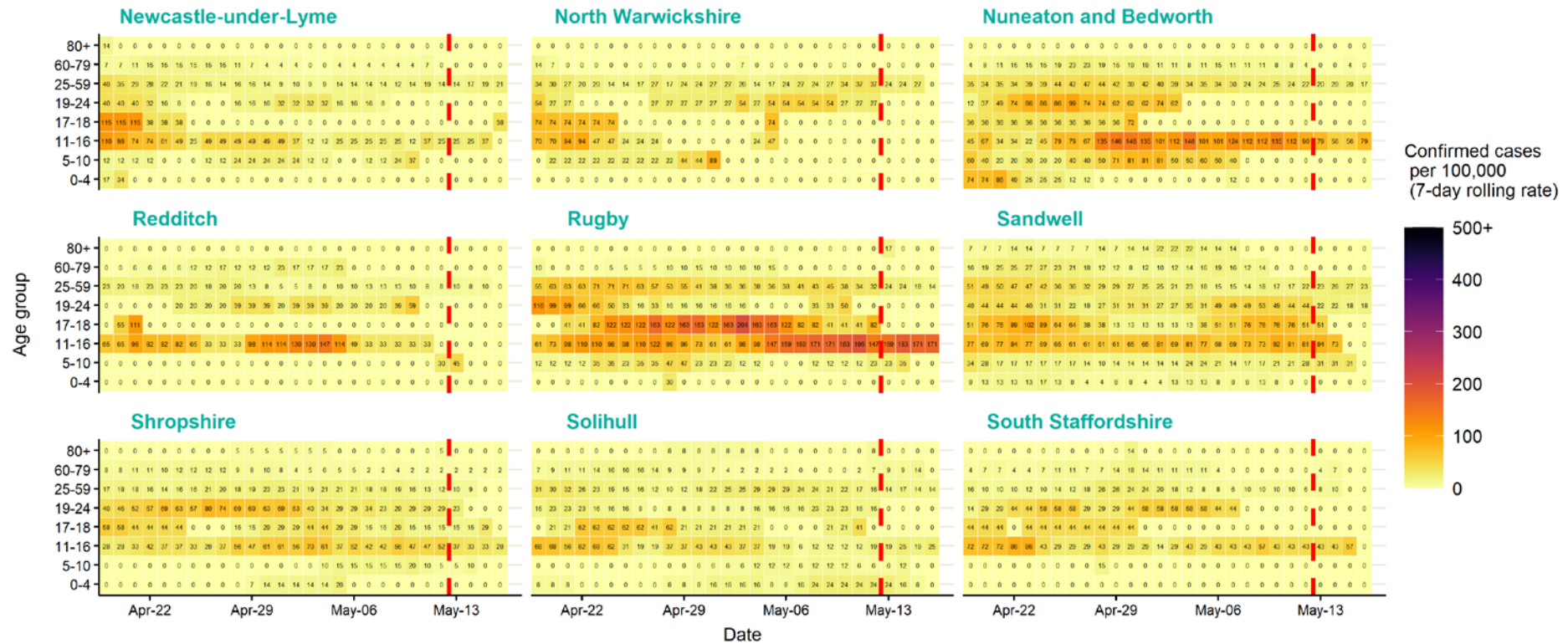

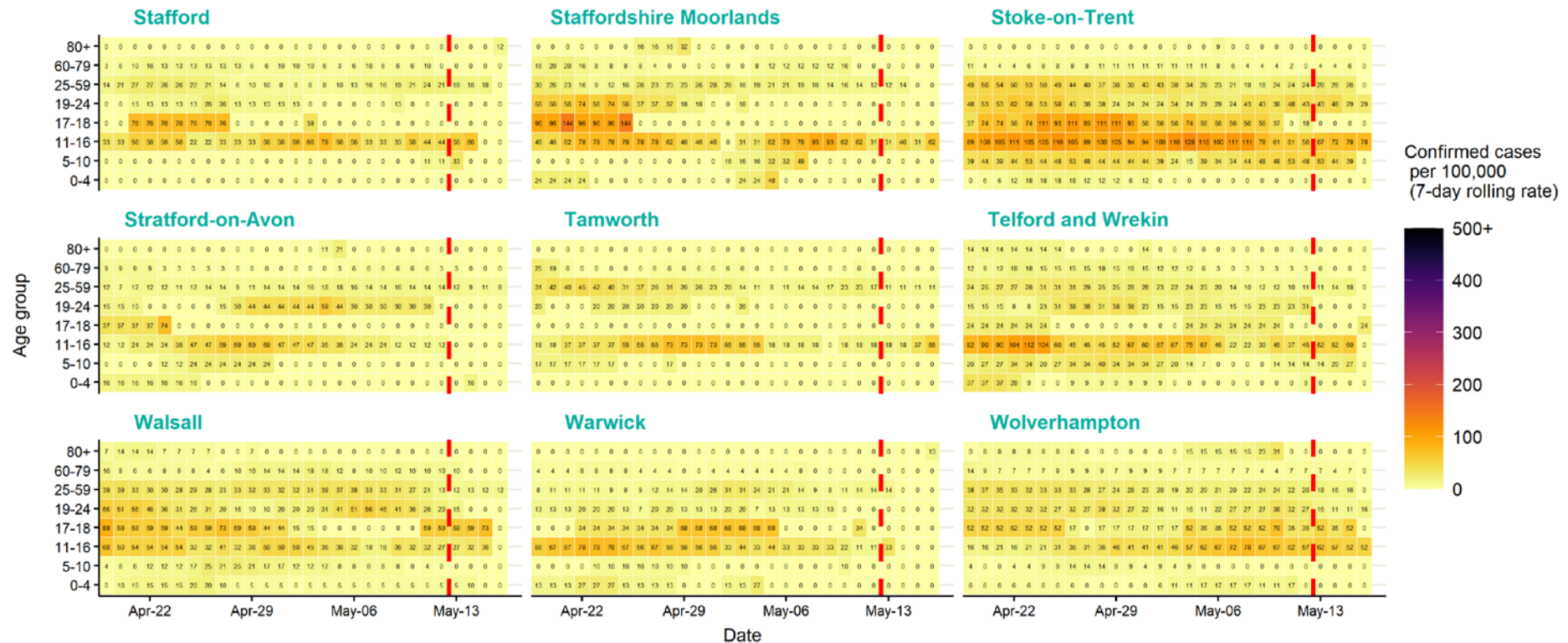

West Midlands age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 19 Apr to 12 May 2021



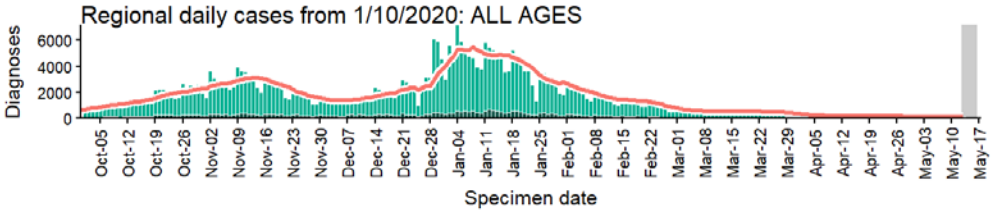
