## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under Rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds of non compliance with an Order of the Tribunal in terms of Rule 37(1)(c) & that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of Rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- 1. On **1 March 2021** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by **8 March 2021** or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- 2. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
